- 1. This is Big Bass only charity tournament presented by Healthy Kidz of Tomorrow. The winner of the biggest bass will win \$500; however if the entries are less than 20 participants then the payout amount will be adjusted accordingly.
- 2. The entry fee is \$30.00 per angler (big bass only). Pre-register online at www.healthykidsoftomorrow.org.
- 3. Contestants may also enter at the ramp (CASH ONLY at the ramp). ENTRY FEES ARE NON REFUNDABLE!
- 4. Boat starting times will be assigned. There will be a shotgun launch once all boats are securely and safely in the water.
- 5. Contestants may fish as two-man teams from the same boat or single entrant. Contestants will choose their own partners.
- 6. Contestants should be at least eighteen (18) years old. If a contestant is under the age of 18 years, his/her partner must be of adult age and the adult partner must assume liability in all matters.
- 7. Contestants must stay together during the tournament at all times. Contestants must stay in the boat. No wading will be allowed.
- 8. Competing boats must stay a minimum of two cast distances apart unless allowed by other boat(s) in the area. Good sportsmanship and courtesy must be practiced at all times.
- 9. All boats must have all required Coast Guard approved safety equipment. All contestants must wear a chest life preserver while motor is running.
- 10. Consumption of alcoholic beverages is not permitted during tournament hours and can be grounds for disqualification.
- 11. Boats must have an operating live well system that can adequately maintain bass. All fish become property of the HKOT and will be released.
- 12. Big Bass will be determined by the total weight of a single fish.
- 13. Boats that are late to weigh-in will be penalized one pound per minute and will be disqualified after 15 minutes.
- 14. Protests must be in writing and submitted to the tournament director prior to the close of the weigh-in scales (as determined by tournament officials).
- 15. Only artificial bait will be allowed. NO LIVE BAIT. Only one rod may be used at any one time per person. No rod in the water while in big motor is running.
