(Mark 9:29 KJV)

As persons who desperately need to <u>PRAY and FAST</u>, we "EXPECT" <u>GOD</u> to immediately respond/reply to our every request. However, we owe of ourselves to GOD, too. MOTE: If unfamiliar with FASTING, TRY ONLY ONE HOUR per day for the number of days you can handle. REMEMBER: GOD KNOWS YOUR HEART. SO, DO NOT OVERDO IT!

Be sure to carefully read ingredients included in all food and beverage items. Watch out for carbohydrates/sugars, fats, and sodium contents.

Note: To reduce stress, some foods/meals may be prepared ahead of time.

PLEASE be aware of your medical condition, then abide by
your medical prescriptions and their restrictions, as well as
physical exercises prescribed by your Physicians.

- 7. Lastly: So that you can relax and enjoy your time with God:
 - a) Gather and read "prior to" Scriptures, references, and other
 materials. Prepare your "Prayer and Scriptural Chart" page ______)
 - b) Try and do house and yard chores before your Fast begins.
 - c) Have medications readily available.
 - d) Which foods/beverages may you have? What foods/beverages must you avoid?
 - e) Decide your daily meal plans.
 - f) To reduce stress, try to have food recipes, meals planned, snacks prepared ahead of time.
 - e) Have everything needed for the Fast easily accessible.

STEP 2 - IMPLEMENT YOUR FAST: (Date:__)

<u>Daily:</u> Prayers to include First day OF YOUR "PRAYER AND FASTING," then, <u>firstly each day:</u>

- 1) **Confess and Repent** for your sins of commission and omission].
- 2) Ask **GOD** for Forgiveness for your sins.
- 3) <u>Give Thanks to **GOD**</u> for: My Spouse, Children, Our Family (lies); <u>EVERYONE</u>
 IN Our Neighborhood/Community/City/County Stare, Nation, World; Ourselves.
- 4) <u>Pray</u> for those without love; those who have no hope, those depressed, suppressed, oppressed; those misfortuned; those without employment, those with little or no finances; those without spiritual contact; those without families; without water, food, shelter, clothing; those ill, maimed; those with all manner of mistreatment/abuse;
- 5) PRAY for the researchers; scientists; doctors, nurses; first responders; health care and safety workers; health and safety protectors; members of the clergy; educators of all kinds; all varieties of essential workers; members of the military; members of various services who are ALL vital to our various communities; members of the military, volunteers in ANY capacity
- 6) PRAY for every person who cannot work OR lost their jobs for the following reasons: a)
 a) NOT tested; b) tested positively; c) afraid of getting virus, if returned to work; d) have no one to care for their children, if parent/guardian returns to work.
- 7) PRAYERS for EVERYONE EVERYWHERE whether directly or indirectly Impacted by the CORONAVIRUS COVID-19 Pandemic/COVID-19, including persons whose parents, children, Family Members, etc. who died or suffered physically, mentally, etc. as a result of this terrible situation.

STEP 3: AFTER YOUR FAST: - (Date:__)

Be careful when you end your Fast. DO NOT RUSH into your regular eating routine. Rather, slowly ease into your regular eating habits, as well as into your normal daily routine.

In fact, it may be more beneficial for you to continue with some of the habits to which you have been accustomed during your "Actual Fast." ("PUTTING GOD FIRST" in your THOUGHTS, SAYINGS, and ACTIONS; daily, frequent prayers, Scripture Readings, Bible Studies; abstinence of certain activities; healthy speech and conversations; healthy attitudes; healthy foods and beverages; good exercise habits and routines; improved, healthy, positive relationships with self and others; in your LOVE FOR YOUR BROTHERS AND SISTERS, as described in the HOLY BIBLE; etc.

NOTE: Your **PRAYER AND FASTING** routine does not have to end here – but – may continue, using the **"ONE HOUR PER DAY PRAYER AND FASTING"** method (The "**ONE HOUR PER DAY FASTING"** is specially designed for persons who ARE NOT accustomed to **FASTING**. It is designed as a one to three day project for persons who are ill, those who cannot "**fast;"** those who are on medications, those who are hospitalized, in a health care facility, etc.; those whose doctors and/or medical care advisors do not agree; those whose care givers/family do not agree; those persons who object, etc.)

[DISCLAIMER: LMMI advocates Fasting as a matter of choice ONLY for persons desiring to participate.)
