
#### Introduction





#### Criterion Theater


#### Acadia Nat'l Park - Bar Harbor Entrance






#### Acadia National Park Visitors Center - Hulls Cove

From April 15 through October 31, begin your visit at Hulls Cove Visitor Center, located on Route 3 north of Bar Harbor. Watch a free 15-minute audiovisual program about the park, available in English, French, German, audio description, and captioned. Plan your visit using a three-dimensional map of the island. 



#### Northeast Harbor



Over the years, Northeast Harbor, Maine, has become famous as much for its summertime residents as it has for its beautiful and protected harbor full of exclusive yachts and sailing vessels. You may be surprised to hear that its actually not an official township but rather part of the town of Mount Desert which covers 25,699 acres and has an approximate population of 2,109 (per the year 2000 census). 


#### Sand Beach

#### Southwest Harbor



Southwest Harbor, Maine, is located at the southwestern entrance to Somes Sound on Mount Desert Island. It is often referred to as the "quiet side" of the island because it has a mellower pace and is an easy distance from the more tourist oriented and busy Bar Harbor, located on the Northeast side of the island. Southwest Harbor has some great shops, galleries and eateries worth checking out. Access to the offshore islands by boat can be found here as well. The approximate population is 1,966 (per year 2000 census) and it encompasses 8,884 acres. Southwest Harbor, Maine, is also home to some great yacht builders. The Hinckley Company, located just south of the town center on the Manset Shore Road, is world renown for its quality of workmanship. Another, Morris Yachts, Inc., is located on the Clark Point Road.




#### Acadia Mountain [Trailhead]




DIFFICULT - One of the most popular trails, Acadia Mountain is accessed from a parking area along Route 102 about two miles south of Somesville on the way to Southwest Harbor on the western side of Mount Desert Island. Rangers frequently lead hikes up Acadia as part of their regular summer programs. The trail goes up and over the summit of Acadia Mountain for a one way distance of about 1 and 1/4 miles and a vertical climb of under 700 feet. Return can be via the fire road along the brook between Acadia and St. Sauveur Mountains, or you can keep going up St. Sauveur and continue down to the parking area at it's base along Route 102 about 1/2 mile south of the Acadia Mountain parking area. Views from Acadia are of Somes Sound and the entrance to Southwest Harbor

TRAILS STARTS - Parking area on Route 102 about two miles south of Somesville ROUNDTRIP DISTANCE - 2.5 miles (4.0 km)
SUMMIT HEIGHT - 680 ft (207 m)





### **Beech Mountain - Valley Trail [Trailhead]**

Beech Mountain lies between Echo Lake and Long Pond (Great Pond on some maps). Its summit is easy to reach from either the Beech Cliff parking area or the pumping station area at the foot of Great Pond. Beech Mountain can also be climbed on its southwest flank, beginning at the south end of Great Pond. An added attraction near Beech Mountain is the Beech Cliff-Canada Cliff area just to the east of the Beech Cliff parking area. These rugged cliffs offer spectacular views of Echo Lake. {from Maine Resource Guide}


[NOTE: Beech Mountain can also be accessed by the Beech Mtn. Parking Area - Follow 102 South and take a right onto Pretty Marsh Road. Take a left onto Ripples Road. Ripples Road becomes Beech Hill Road. Follow Beech Hill Road to Beech Mountain.]

TRAILS STARTS - Pump Station Parking Lot at Southern end of Long Pond ROUNDTRIP DISTANCE - ~2.5 miles (4.0 km) SUMMIT HEIGHT - 839 ft (256 m)





MODERATE / DIFFICULT - There are 2 trails up to the top of Beehive - 1 is a moderate climb, the other is more DIFFICULT and not recommended for small children - iron rungs on ledges of exposed cliffs. Your party can split at a trail head and meet up with each other at the top. The more DIFFICULT climb is to the RIGHT when the trail splits.

TRAIL STARTS - 100 feet north of Sand Beach Parking Area.




MODERATE - Open ascent, Frenchman's Bay views. After turning onto one-way section of Park Loop Road - towards Sand Beach - go little less than 1/2 mile. Look for a small parking turnout on LEFT side of Park Loop Road. Marker for Northridge Trailhead is across the road on RIGHT side of road.

TRAIL STARTS - North Ridge Trail Parking Area on the Park Loop Road.

ROUNDTRIP DISTANCE - 4.4 miles (7.0 km).

SUMMIT HEIGHT - 1528 ft (466 m)


### Dorr Mtn. - Canon Brook Trail [Trailhead]




DIFFICULT - A steady and sometimes steep climb. The Ladder Trail will take you over hundreds of stone steps leading up to the Dorr mountain segment. There are also metal ladders / stairs to take you over the big boulders. At the summit, and along the way, you will have views of Frenchman's Bay, Cadillac Mountain, Bar Harbor, pink granite rocks, and forests. This mountain is named for the founder of Acadia National Park.


ROUNDTRIP DISTANCE: CANON BROOK TRAIL - 4.8 miles (7.7 km) --- LADDER TRAIL (More Difficult) - 3.5 miles (5.63 km)

TRAIL STARTS: Canon Brook parking area off Rte 3. Look for an opening in the bushes just South of the Tarn on Rte. 3. The mountain is actually northwest of this point. SUMMIT: 1,265 feet (386 m)





### Flying Mountain [Trailhead]



Flying Mountain is one of the lowest peaks in Acadia, yet it offers some of the best views. It can be climbed as part of a short out-and-back scramble or a longer loop. This scenic trail over tiny Flying Mountain leaves the east side of the parking area at the Fernald Cove end of the Valley Cove truck road and rises quickly to the summit. It follows the summit ridge north to a point overlooking Valley cove, then descends quickly and steeply through spruce woods. At the edge of Valley Cove, the trail follows the shore north over rock slides and under forbidding Eagle Cliff to end at a junction with the Acadia Mountain Trail at Man O'War Brook. At Valley Cove, the north terminus of the truck road can be located up the bank about 75 yards south from the water's edge. For an easy return to the Fernald Cove parking area, follow the road south for about 0.5 mi.

TRAIL START - Parking area is .8 mile down Fernald Point Rd from intersection with Rte. 102 ROUNDTRIP DISTANCE - 0.6 miles (0.97 km) [Short Route] --- 4.6 miles (7.4 km) [Longer Route] SUMMIT - 284 ft. (87 m)





MODERATE - Forest opening to granite ascent. Magnificent views of Sand Beach & Thunder Hole from summit.

SUMMIT HEIGHT - 522 ft (159 m)





### **Great Head Trail**




MODERATE - Granite steps at beginning of trail lead to path that will take you towards the pink granite cliffs. Fairly steep climb at times, there are plenty of places to stop and look back over Sand Beach and Beehive. Once at the top, it's nice stroll along paths and outcroppings.

TRAIL STARTS - At the eastern end of Sand Beach.

(You can park at Sand Beach and walk across beach to trailhead.)

ROUNDTRIP - 1.4 miles (2.2 km)





#### **Hunters Beach Trail**




This short .3 mile walk goes thru the forest and follows along side of Hunters Brook down to the ocean. The trail is rough and has a lot of tree roots and stones on the path, so be careful as you hike. Once at the beach, you'll see the effects of constant tides pounding on the "cobble" stones and notice the cliffs to your left overlooking the bold ocean.


DIFFICULT - From the summit, views of Somes Sound and vistas od Northeast Harbor. Although the National Park Service has a parking area designated as Parkman Mountain, there is no direct access to the trail(s) leading to the peak of Parkman. If you want to climb Parkman from this direction, continue down Rte. 198 South approx. 1/4 mile and park at the Norumbega parking area on right. Go across the street near the north end of the lot and follow the trail marker there for a few hundred yards. The trail will split, and the trail to Parkman will head off to the left.

TRAIL STARTS - from Norumbega Trailhead parking lot ROUNDTRIP DISTANCE - 2.4 mi (3.9 km) SUMMIT HEIGHT - 940 ft (287 m)


MODERATELY DIFFICULT - The trail begins on Jordan Pond's southern shore near the boat ramp amic beautiful blueberry bushes. The trail offers views of Eagle Lake, Cranberry Isles, Seal Harbor and Frenchman's Bay. Be sure to check out the stone arch bridge crossing Jordan Stream.

TRAIL STARTS - Southern shore of Jordan Pond ROUNDTRIP DISTANCE - 3.3 mi (5.3 km) SUMMIT - 1,196 ft (365 m)





DIFFICULT - Not recommended for small children. Iron rungs and ladders on exposed cliffs, very steep. Note: Trail is often closed in May - mid-August due to peregrine falcons breeding on the cliffs.

TRAIL STARTS - Precipice Parking Area.








### Sargent Mountain [Trailhead]

MODERATELY DIFFICULT - At 1,379 feet, Sargent Mountain is the second highest mountain in Acadia National Park. Taking the Brook Trail and starting from the Norumbega parking lot on Rte. 3, the roundtrip is just over 4 miles . ( Cross over to the east side of Rte. 3 to pick up the trail.) The top portion of the trail is the toughest, but worth the effort. From the summit, you can see the Appalachian Mountains.

TRAIL STARTS - Norumbega parking area on Rte. 3 - just north of Upper Hadlock Pond ROUNDTRIP DISTANCE - 4.2 miles. (6.7 km) SUMMIT HEIGHT - 1,379 ft (420 m)





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## Bar Harbor Congregational Church
