Here's what we're learning in the month of February:

JESUS ANOINTED (LUKE 7:36-50)

February 05

Brite Idea: Jesus forgives us.

Memory Verse: For you, O Lord, are good and forgiving. **Psalm 86:5a**

He Question: Can Jesus forgive anyone for anything?

Jesus has the power to forgive anyone who comes to Him with a heart ready to repent, or turn away from sin and turn towards Him. No sin is too big for Him to forgive.

We Question: How does being forgiven change things for us?

When Jesus forgives us, we can have a relationship with God and we can live a life full of thankfulness to Him and worship of Him.

JESUS AND THE CHILDREN (LUKE 18:15-17)

February 12

Brite Idea: Jesus loves kids.

Memory Verse: But Jesus called them to him, saying, "Let the children come to me." **Luke 18:16a**

He Question: Does Jesus only love the good kids?

In Jesus' eyes, there aren't "good kids" and "bad kids." Jesus loves every single kid exactly as they are.

We Question: What do we have to do for Jesus to love us?

We don't do anything. Jesus loves us first. When we understand how much Jesus loves us, we live our life to honor Him.

BARTIMAEUS (LUKE 18:35-42, MARK 10:46-52)

February 19

Brite Idea: Jesus hears us when we call out to Him.

Memory Verse: Then you will call upon me and come and pray to me, and I will hear you. **Jeremiah 29:12**

He Question: Does Jesus always answer us right away?

Jesus always hears and always answers, but that doesn't mean He always does what we ask. His answer may be "no" or "not yet".

We Question: What can we ask Jesus?

Jesus cares about our struggles and we can ask Jesus anything, anytime. We should seek to pray according to His will, or in line with what He wants.

ZACCHAEUS (LUKE 19:1-10)

February 26

Brite Idea: Jesus came to save sinners.

Memory Verse: For the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost. **Luke 19:10**









He Question: Why does Jesus care about sinners?

Jesus loves all people and all people sin. Jesus came to make a way for sinners to be made right with God.

We Question: How should we treat sinners?

We should show everyone the love of Jesus. Just like Jesus, we can treat everyone with kindness without agreeing with their sin.
