Match the print to the animal, and the animal to the picture!




deer

heron

herons have big feet and long toes to help them balance and stop them sinking in the mud




squirrel

squirrels leave complicated tracks, lots of pad and claw marks



otter

otters have five toes, you can sometimes see webbing between them



dog

dog paw prints have four toes with claw marks and a rear pad



badger

badgers have five toes and the large pad behind them is shaped like a kidney



duck

ducks have webbed feet to help them swim, they leave very distinctive marks in the mud



fox

foxes have four toes, the rear pad is usually the same size as the toes
