GENERAL SESSION MINUTES

Consideration and discussion of comments and complaints from the public. The Fire District Board is not permitted to discuss or take action on any item raised in the call to the public. However, individual Board members may be permitted to respond to criticism directed to them. Otherwise, the Board may direct that staff review the matter or that the matter be placed on a future agenda. The Fire District Board cannot discuss or take legal action on any issue raised during the Call to the Public due to restrictions of the Open Meeting Law.

6. Financial Report

Chairman Turcotte discussed the end of the year closeout. The district closed out a FEMA grant that was near target execution. The executed budget was within 5% of target. The hold over funds were put into Capital expense for the next fiscal year. He then went over the individual bank balance's and the FY 2023 budget.

7. Chief's Report-Chief Apodaca discusses major changes in the area with mutual aid-partnering with Mammoth last 2 months and everything has been going good, July conference went great, 6 volunteers will be attending fire school, the Recruitment and Retention MDFC meeting was successful, National Night out went well and was well attended by the public, for the year we are at 101 calls which exceeds last years calls.
