# **QUESTION #8 - Old Testament Appearances of Christ**

In our study from Jacob in week #6 ("The Wrestling Match"), it was mentioned about the times the Lord appeared to man in the Old Testament. These are "pre-incarnate" appearances (also known as "Theophanies" or "Christophanies". What are the times that the Lord appeared to man before He became flesh?

The following is a list of times in the Old Testament where God appeared to man...

## 4 <u>#1 – HAGAR (Sarai's handmaid) – Genesis 16:7-16</u>

- v.7 "the angel of the LORD..."
- v.10 offers some insight as to how we know it was God making an appearance...
  - o "...I will multiply thy seed..."
- ALSO v.13 adds to it...
  - "...And she called the name of the LORD that spake unto her, Thou God seest me..."

### **#2 – ABRAHAM – Genesis 18:1-23**

- v.1 "And the LORD appeared unto him..."
- v.3 Abraham is speaking...
  - o "And said, My Lord..."

## **#3 – ABRAHAM, again, AS HE WAS ABOUT TO OFFER ISAAC AS A BURNT** SACRIFICE – Genesis 22:1-19

- v.11 makes a reference to "the angel of the LORD".
- v.12 it is the "angel" talking and he says...
  - o "...seeing thou hast not withheld thy son, thine only son <u>from me</u>."

### **#** <u>#4 – JACOB and the "WRESTLING MATCH" – Genesis 32:24-30</u>

- v. 24 Jacob was wrestling with "a man".
- v.30 Jacob said...
  - "...for I have seen God face to face..."

### #5 – MOSES and the BURNING BUSH – Exodus 3:1-6

- Many references here leaving NO DOUBT that this was God making an appearance to man in the Old Testament.
  - o v.2 "...the angel of the LORD appeared unto him..."
  - o v.4 "...God called unto him out of the midst of the bush..."
  - v.6 "...he said, Moreover I am the God of..."
  - v.6 "...And Moses hid his face; for he was afraid to look upon God."

## #6 – IN THE CLOUD THAT LED THE ISRAELITES THROUGH THE DESERT – Exodus 13:20-22

- v.21 explains how this was God (the LORD) -
  - "...the LORD went before them by day in a pillar of a cloud..."
- We also have a *<u>New Testament</u>* that sheds even more light on this:
  - I Corinthians 10:1-4

#### #7 – GIDEON – Judges 6:11-24

### QUICK BACKGROUND...

- Because of their rebellion and idolatry (5:8; 6:10), God delivered the children of Israel into the hands of the Midianites for 7 years (v.1)
- ✤ 6:7 they cried out for deliverance
- ✤ 6:11 God raises up Gideon

- v.11 The angel of the LORD appears to Gideon under an oak tree
- v.13, 15 Gideon refers to the angel...

o "...Oh my Lord..."

• v.14-24 – much 'back and forth' addressing and referring to the angel as "the LORD".

### **#8 – THE ANGEL THAT APPEARED TO SAMSON'S MOTHER – Judges 13:2-22**

- Manoah was Samson's father
- Samson's mother's name is not recorded in scripture.
- v.3 the "angel of the LORD" appears to Mrs. Manoah.
- v.6,8 he is referred to as "a man of God".
- v.18 The angel says that his name is "...a secret..."
- v.19-20 The angel makes a "supernatural exit".
- v.20-21 reveal who this "angel" and "man of God" was...
  - o "...because we have seen God..."

### 🖊 <u>#9 – ISAIAH – Isaiah 6:1-8</u>

- There is no doubt that Isaiah saw God (the Lord) here.
  - o v.1 "...I saw also the Lord..."
  - v.1-7 detailed descriptions of what he SAW, what he HEARD, and what he FELT (v.6-7).
  - v.8 "Also I heard the voice of the Lord, saying..."

### **POINT TO PONDER...**

We know WHO Isaiah saw (the Lord), but we do not know HOW he saw him...

- ✓ Could have been a dream/vision.
- Could have been God opening Isaiah's eyes and giving him a literal glimpse into heaven.

### **#** <u>#10 – THE FOURTH MAN IN THE FIRE – Daniel 3:23-25</u>

- There is no record of what may have been said between the three Hebrew children and Jesus.
- There is no reference mentioned anywhere else in scripture to this account.
- All we have is King Nebuchadnezzar's description: "...the form of the fourth is like the Son of God."
  - There is only ONE who could be described that way!

## **4** <u>CLOSING:</u>

- Some have asked: why doesn't God appear today to people like He did to those Old Testament saints?
  - <u>FIRST</u>, we have a completed Bible Word of God.
    - I Samuel 3:1
  - <u>SECOND</u>, we have the Holy Ghost.
    - John 16:13
