Our code of ethics represents ethics with the Boondocks K9 Sar - Cert performing services and will continue to display the highest levels of service ethics in all of our missions. It also addresses the ethical standards of the organization, what is expected of each member and volunteer.

This includes:

Good communication, honesty, integrity, fair conduct, compliance with rules and regulations, obey any applicable law and report any type of violation.

I. Public Sector:

Provide equal opportunities to all members and volunteers

II. Public Relations Sector:

- Avoid insulting rivalry with others, which could lead to unethical and much less acceptable behavior
- Publication and promotions will be carried out for the good and relationship of the community and its inhabitants
- Members and volunteers shall work to provide community satisfaction through commitment, honesty, courtesy, and respect.

III. Communication Sector:

- Members and volunteers must provide correct and accurate information to their peers and the community
- Members and volunteers must communicate without withholding crucial information

IV. Honesty and Integrity:

- Between members, volunteers and the community it is very important to our organization
- Every member and volunteer must act with the best intention

V. Competences:

 All members and volunteers must have the skills and training required for each assigned task as well as a sense of professionalism. Members and volunteers must have the ability to meet established standards

VI. Good behavior:

- The organization has zero tolerance for irreverent behavior and conduct such as: sexual misconduct, insubordination, outright disregard for discipline, inappropriate use of social media, and others.
- Respect between members and volunteers is essential

VII. Violations:

- Members and volunteers should report any suspicions of illegal and unethical conduct
- Any member or volunteer who reports a violation will be protected

If a violation of the code of ethics is suspected, an investigation is processed. Every member and volunteer has the right of an appeal to the board.
