



Hanging Scripture Placard

Supplies Needed:

- 5 large craft sticks
- Wide tape (clear packing tape works well)
- · Glue stick or liquid glue
- Ribbon
- Colored paper (1 sheet)
- Scissors
- Bible scripture of your choice (next page)
- Embellishments: beads, craft gems, craft poms, etc.
- Optional: Glitter and/or paint



All of the pictured examples were designed by YAHWEH's precious little lambs!

Instructions:

- 1. Tear off a large piece tape and press down a craft stick on left side of tape. Line another craft stick on top of it and repeat until all 5 sticks are stuck on the tape. Repeat with another strip of tape (about 3 total) until the back is completely secured with tape.
- 2. Tape each end of a small piece of ribbon (about 9") to the back of your placard.
- 3. If you prefer, you can cut a square piece of colored construction paper to fit the back and glue it over the tape. This will give a nice backing cover to your placard.
- 4. Glue bible verses to front of placard.
- 5. Decorate the front of your Bible scripture placard with your embellishments.
- 6. Let the glue dry for at least 30 minutes and then it's ready to hang in a place you like.

Hint: If you don't have the craft items, you can use any item you have in the house or even outdoors and it will work just fine! Be creative and have fun!
