RESUMING IN-PERSON WORSHIP: We have resumed weekly Sunday services in person at 8:30am and 11:00am in the sanctuary. Masks and social distancing are required, as well as additional measures and modifications to our worship services, similar to our worship last fall. Even if you have already received a COVID vaccine, these measures are still necessary, as the CDC is uncertain as to whether the vaccine prevents transmission of the virus. Worship will still be recorded and posted online weekly, by approximately 5pm on Sunday.
