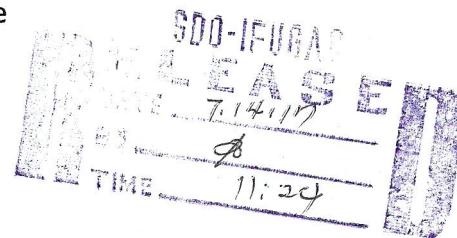

Subject: **SUBMISSION OF TWO (2) COMMUNITY VOLUNTEERS FOR THE OVERSEEING OF THE PROJECT IMPLEMENTATION OF THE DEPED COMPUTERIZATION PROGRAM (DCP) EQUIPMENTS FOR UNENERGIZED SCHOOLS**

Date: July 14, 2017

1. The DepEd forged partnership with the United Nation Development Programme (UNDP) on the procurement, delivery and installation of computer equipment for the schools nationwide. Likewise, UNDP partnered with different Civil Society Organizations (CSO's) to help in ensuring better implementation of the project in terms of right quantity, right quality, right time, right place and its functionality. UNDP and DepEd called their CSO partners Concerned Citizens of Abra for Good Government (CPaG) or Citizens Participating in Governance.
2. In monitoring DCP project implementation where CPaG is involved, the CPaG partners recruit, capacitate and deploy school-based/community volunteers to oversee the DCP project implementation. As a result of the citizens' participation in monitoring the project, fast feedback on the status of implementation was generated through the on-line reporting. Issues and concerns regarding the project implementation that needed for immediate action especially in the school readiness were resolved through the collaborative efforts of UNDP, DepEd, CSO's and Citizen monitors.
3. With the good results of the UNDP-DepEd-CPaG partnership in the previous implementation to other divisions, the same strategy will be applied to the procurement and delivery of DCP equipment to **unenergized** schools nationwide. The Concerned Citizens of Abra for Good Government (CCAGG) is the CPaG partner on the project on DCP for unenergized schools in Region 1, 2, and CAR.
4. **The division office is now developing pools of community volunteers who are within the location of the school concerned and who are willing to be trained for an honorarium (for further clarification) to be given by the recruiting party for abovementioned purposes and for future references when same concerns will be requested by other link agencies.**
