The theme for the convention was "Choose Joy" with over 500 attendees, consisting of 157 first timers, who gathered at the Rosen Plaza Hotel, Orlando, Fl.

The GFWC FL Pre-Convention Board of Directors Meeting was called to order on Friday evening with Dianne Foerster, GFWC FL President, presiding.

Following the business meeting, the 1st Annual GFWC FL recycled "Trashion" Fashion Show was held with a representative from each district. The goal was to design and construct an outfit using recycled materials. Outfits were modeled and judged - what creativity our members have!

Saturday morning, I joined Linda DiPietro at the First Time Attendees workshop.
