### **New Exhibit at the Virginia Quilt Museum**

“No Boundaries” breaks through the conventions on what art quilts can be.

Harrisonburg, Va.- The Virginia Quilt Museum is opening a new exhibit on April 20, 2021. Artists from across the country are featured in this new one time only show.

“The museum is pleased to offer a juried exhibition for the first time ever, and we are so excited to be working with juror, Marcia Young of Fiber Arts Now,” says, Susan Farmer, the Executive Director of the Virginia Quilt Museum, “We are also happy to have Artistic Artifacts as the sponsor of this show.
