27.0 TOTAL CREDITS TO EARN A MHS DIPLOMA

- Pass all the **REQUIRED CORE LISTED BELOW**

4.0 ENGLISH-Complete ALL of the following:

- 1.0 English 9
- 1.0 English 10
- 1.0 English 11
- 1.0 English 12 (Applied & Advanced Language Arts Courses)

3.0 MATHEMATICS -Complete ALL of the following:

- 1.0 Secondary Math Level 1
- 1.0 Secondary Math Level 2
- 1.0 Secondary Math Level 3/ or take a 3rd year Math Option
- ♦ It is recommended to take 4 years of math to be college/career ready

3.0 SCIENCE -Complete 3.0 of the following:

- 1.0 Earth Science
- 1.0 Biology

- 1.0 Foundation or Applied & Advanced Science Courses
