





We have had fantastic fundraising efforts in the last few months starting off with an amazing achievement from Kim and Dec who ran a half marathon last October and managed to raise the grand total of £3866. A big thank you to them and all who contributed.

Kim was in action again and ran a marathon in April (half marathon is so last season) a great personal achievement and she raised a further £1477, for club funds.

Easter brought out some tennis bunnies and helped raise £88, which was on top of the £153 from last years Xmas Jumper event.

We also need to thank Spar for a generous
£2000 donation to help us complete our
resurfacing project.

In addition we are extremely grateful to have received £10,000 from a very generous donor.

Thanks to the massive team fund raising effort, many grant applications and also a team weeding project! our new courts are now a reality. Further work will be continuing in June when the final coloured surface will be painted on. We will then have courts to be proud of. No more slippery mud puddles and dodgy bounces.

A huge thank you to Ron for leading this project, approaching potential sponsors, researching and applying for grants, finding the right contractors and supervising the build. It has been the culmination of 24 months of hard work behind the scenes.

Since the laying of our beautiful new court surface we have unfortunately had a set back involving a sink hole on the baseline probably due to a collapsed drain.

Again Ron and several members of the committee are working hard behind the scenes to find a solution and minimise disruption to the tennis season. We will keep you informed about progress.

In the meantime please take care around court 1 and this is obviously not in use for matches.

Court 2 is safe to play on.

Team captains are rearranging home matches. We all hope that the courts will be back to their former glory as soon as possible.
