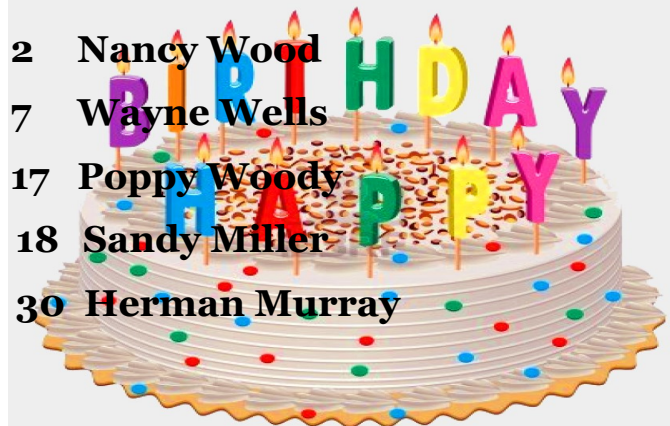

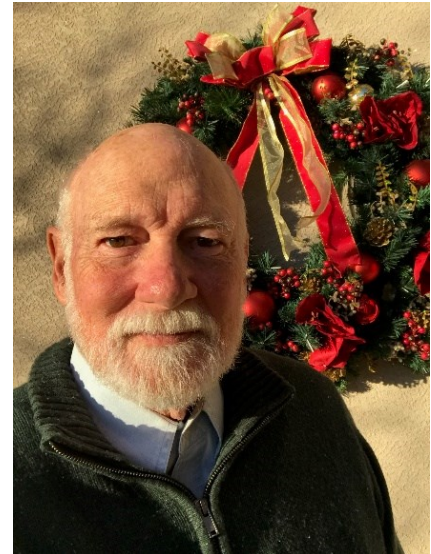




Council Leader's Message

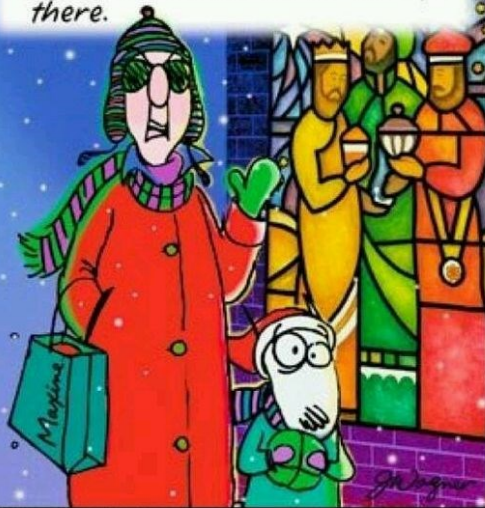
