The Holy Trinity

Definition:

The Holy Trinity is the doctrine/theology that says, "God is one God who exists co-equally and co-eternally in three persons, the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit."

The Holy Trinity

Definition:

- >One God in three persons
- >One substance, three subsistences (persons)
 - >Subsistence a real being; the condition of remaining in existence
