# September Speech-a-thon Speech Contest

## Here's the Preliminary Plan and How All this Works:

We are looking for a total of 12 Power Pals to compete in our 1<sup>st</sup> annual September Speech-a-thon Speech Contest.

There will be 3 categories of Speeches with up to 4 Contestants in each.

Contestants may compete in any category of their choosing but may only compete in one category unless there are vacant spots that need to be filled.

Speaking spots will be filled on a first come first served basis and contestants will then be randomly assigned their speaking order within each group category.

### The categories are:

Group #1: Humorous

Group #2: Informational

Group #3: Inspirational

**Note:** Speeches must be 10-15 minutes max. Any speech less than 9 minutes will be disqualified. Any speech over 16 minutes will be disqualified.

Contestants will be judged by all the Power Pal Peers who are not competing in any category. One winner will be announced from each Group at the Sunday Awards Brunch Recognition Program.

## - Judges Form -

Although speakers will simply be ranked subjectively in order of presentation preferences by their Power Pal Peers as 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, and 4<sup>th</sup> for each category, this general form may be used as a helpful criteria guide in determining the contestant rankings.

This form is similarly based on the PowerTalk Power Club Speech Evaluation Forms.

On a scale of 1-30 pts. with 15 pts. being the "average," please rate each speaker in the following sections and total up your score at the bottom of the page for each contestant.

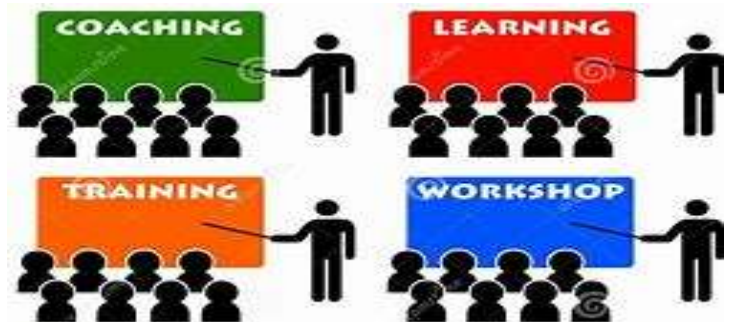

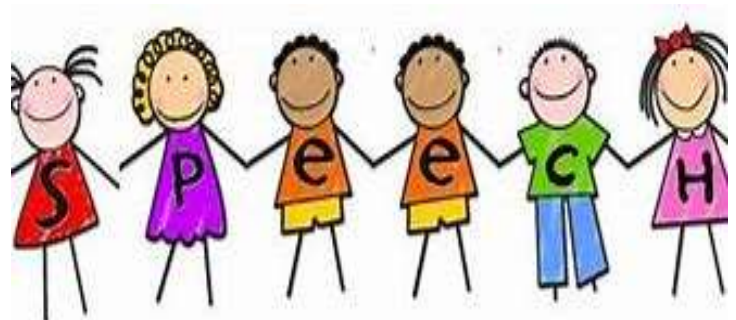
