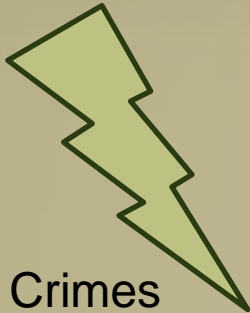

## ENFORCEMENT: Making Our Parish Safer

### Since Taking Office:

- **Reduced Violent Crimes Against Persons by 41%\***
- **Reduced Homicides by 45%\***
- **Reduced Property Crime by 24%\***



Violent Crimes  
Decrease!!

### 2018-2019

- **Crimes Against Persons DOWN by more than 33%**
  - **Robberies DOWN 26%**
  - **Assaults DOWN 50%**
- **Burglaries DOWN 18%**
- **Motor Vehicle Theft DOWN 15%**

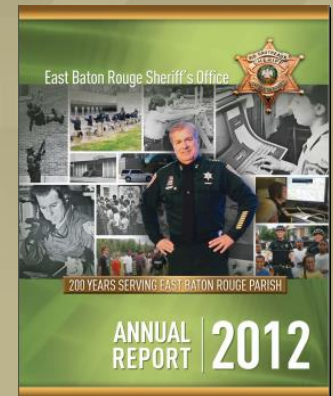
**RESULTS:** Millions of \$\$\$\$ in cash and drugs seized.

# Services Provided to ENTIRE Parish

- **DARE** in 43 schools throughout the parish
- **School Drug Task Force** responds to incidents at all schools
- **Narcotics** makes numerous arrests and seizures in multiple jurisdictions
- **Civil Services** delivers subpoenas and writs throughout the parish
- **Community Outreach and Policing** throughout parish
- **Parish Prison** secures and rehabilitates ALL booked into parish prison from multiple jurisdictions
- **Court Security** provides courthouse and courtroom security for the parish
- **Investigation Assists** on crime scenes in city jurisdictions
- **Traffic Support** offers support and assistance for other agencies working crashes, fires, etc. inside
- **Task Forces** ATF, DEA, Delta Drug, FBI, ICAC, LSP Fugitive, VCU, JTF-7, Crime Stoppers and TRUCE
- **River Security** provides port and river security on the Mississippi
- **Calls to Service-** will respond whenever requested anywhere in parish





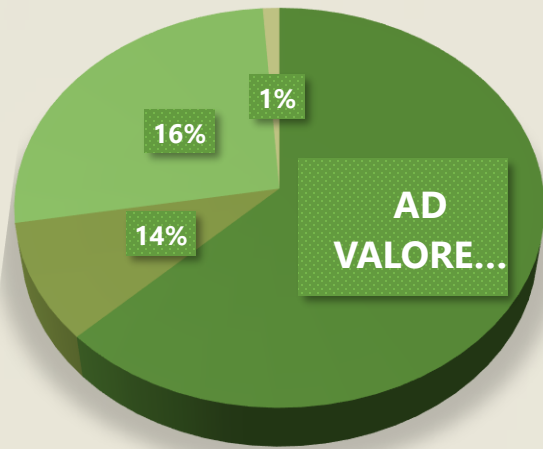

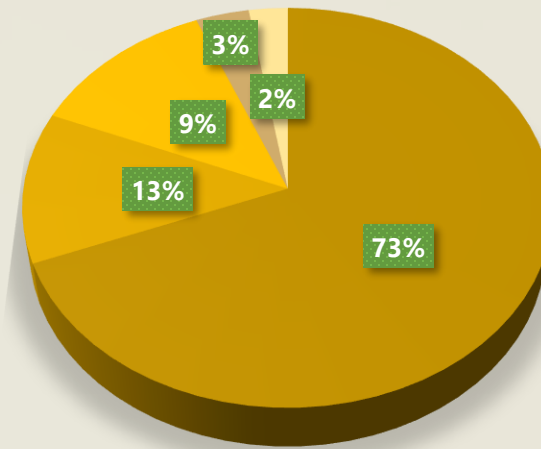
# { How the Sheriff's Office is Funded }

## { The 3 Millages }

- AD VALOREM TAXES - Consists of 3 Millages
  - Special Law Enforcement (SLED)  
4.36 mills- PERMANENT since 1977
  - Renew Every 10 years:
    - **Additional Special Law Enforcement  
3.73 mills- since 1981**
    - Additional Special Law Enforcement  
6.90 mills- since 1994

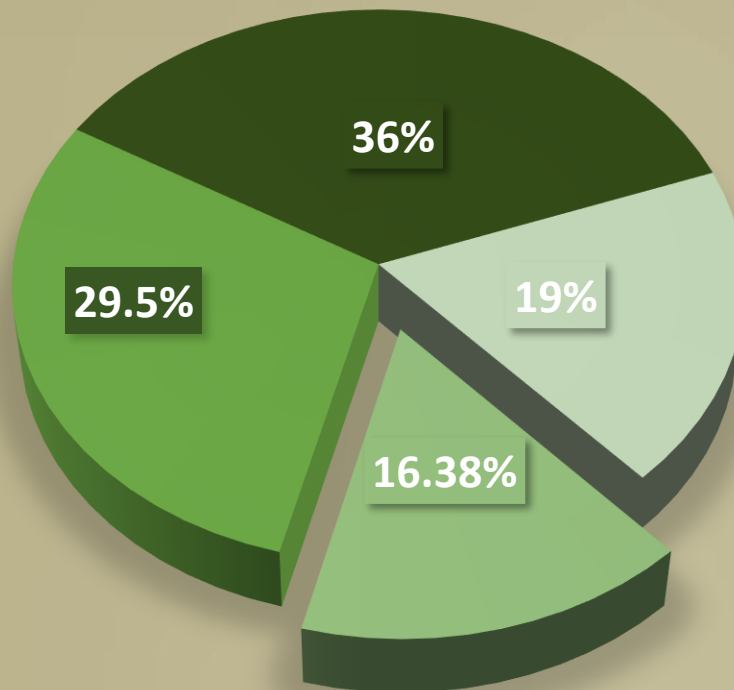
**The 3.73 millage tax is on the ballot on April 4, 2020.**
