## **Becoming a Partnership**

- 1- Sign an agreement.
- 2- The incoming Organization is required to send us copies of all of the legal documents they may have.
- 3- We both have to agree on project management systems
- 4- Any institution that doesn't have the appropriate legal documents, can still sign a partnership agreement with OIGM but, the institution has to agree that it cannot be part of any high level projects OIGM may be leading. Otherwise, it cannot be a co-signer.
- 5- If this Organization is creating a project on their own, the project has to be led by OIGM for legal matters.
- 6- In case there are projects that have a common goal, OIGM and the incorporated institution will get together to lay down the percentage of participants or efforts in which each institution will reach said goal.
- 7-After welcoming any institution in writing, OIGM will send this institution a certificate which will serve as proof that the Organization is working as alongside OIGM.
