

## **Meet Our New Pastor**

It's an honor to introduce Nathan Peterson. He has been called as senior pastor of Gila Valley Baptist Church. Nathan has been serving in ministry since 2007. He began serving the bride of Christ as a sports intern at a church in Allen, Texas. Nathan founded a consultant company called Faithson Solutions in 2009 that now serves hundreds of businesses and churches yearly. Through 2013 Nathan received promotions throughout the church leading to the positions of Associate Minister of Sports and then Student Pastor. During this time Nathan took some seminary classes at Wilmington School of the Bible. Nathan started a new season of ministry as a missionary to a church in Pottsboro, Texas. This is where he met his wife Amanda who served at a sister church in the same town.

After prayer and wisdom from trusted ministry partners, Nathan followed Amanda's calling in ministry through 2015 leading into a season of lay-leadership in the church. During this time Nathan consulted with local county governments regarding volunteer and project management during the Ebola scare in North Texas.

After serving as a lay leader in the church, Pastor Nathan was ordained as a respected and fruitful minister of the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Nathan led his sending church from Sherman, Texas in discipleship and student ministry activities before realizing his calling to the senior pastorate role.

grow in your faith. Learning and acting on these studies will move us beyond knowing the importance of witnessing to others and to help us apply these principles in our own lives.





He has a plan today. He isn't waiting —He is making new life even when the ground beneath our feet is starting to wake up.

Sometimes life gets so overwhelming that we feel as though we are caught in quicksand. The problem with quicksand is that when someone gets stuck in it, they usually resort to what comes naturally to them. They thrash and flail their arms as they try to climb out. Unfortunately, this just makes things worse. Since quicksand is a combination of sand mixed with water, it doesn't have the friction of sand on sand. Without this friction, a person has nothing to push against to extract themself. They just sink down even deeper.

To get free from quicksand, you must shun the natural response and do what seems unnatural. You must fight your inclinations and simply relax. Relaxing will slow down the sinking and allow you to paddle gently, just like treading water. It will give you time to either have someone pull you out or to slowly paddle to more solid ground. Life can often feel like quicksand. We get sucked into the drama, pain and loss that life brings our way. And while our natural inclination is to fight our way out by leveraging all our strength, doing so will usually only cause us to sink further. God's ways are higher than our ways. His thoughts are higher than our thoughts. In times of struggle, He asks us to let go of our own solutions and trust His solutions. He asks us to abide in Him and in His word. He asks us to simply believe. In the words of Jesus, "Do not let your heart be troubled; believe in God, believe also in Me" (John 14:1). Tony Evans 1-21-21
