

# Folkestone and Hythe Birds

## Tetrad Guide: TR13 Y


(Seabrook Stream, Newington, Peene and Cheriton West)



### Introduction

The tetrad contains most of the Seabrook Stream SSSI, which is flanked by alder carr woodland, an area of scrub and mixed woodland between Horn Street and Pond Hill Road, the Newington and Peene villages, and surrounding farmland which includes a small farm pond. A significant proportion of the tetrad is occupied by the Channel Tunnel Terminal and the western end of the town of Cheriton.

## Habitats and birds

The alder carr woodland along the Seabrook Stream can attract Siskins in good numbers, with a peak count of 100 in February 2009, and a typical range of woodland species also occur, including Marsh Tit, whilst Spotted Flycatcher formerly bred. There are numerous wet flushes or fens which are favoured by Woodcock, with a maximum of seven present in January 2010, and once Jack Snipe (in January 2002).

The area of scrub and mixed woodland between Horn Street and Pond Hill Road has produced some noteworthy sightings, with the most significant being a Pallas's Warbler in January 2014 (which also ranged into the adjacent tetrad TR13 X).

The habitats surrounding the Newington and Peene villages have also attracted a few notable birds, including a Nightingale holding territory near the former railway line in 2006, a singing Cetti's Warbler in spring 2019 and two Wood Larks in November 2019, whilst the small farm pond has breeding Little Grebe and wintering Water Rail.

The Channel Tunnel Terminal has a significant colony of roof-nesting gulls, with up to four pairs of Lesser Black-backed Gulls and 120 pairs of Herring Gulls nesting in recent years. These may be counted from Peene Quarry (in TR13 Z). It also hosts a large Pied Wagtail roost within the former (with 800+ counted in December 2001, though the area is not accessible without special permission).

Cheriton town has attracted Waxwings on several occasions (with a peak of 200 in the Tesco car park in December 2010), whilst its football pitches at The Stadium can hold large numbers of Mediterranean Gulls.

Risborough Barracks holds one of the few remaining local House Martin colonies, which may attract Hobbies, and Black Redstarts have possibly bred here on occasion.

Overflying raptors have included Osprey, Honey Buzzard and Red Kite, whilst other notable flyovers have comprised Fulmar, Little Egret and Green Sandpiper. Firecrest, Ring Ouzel, Wheatear, Sedge Warbler, Reed Warbler, Garden Warbler, Black Redstart, Whinchat, Tree Pipit and Crossbill have also been recorded on passage.

## Access and parking

There is a limited area of parking on Horn Street at the very southern end of the tetrad, just south of Underhill Road, or it is possible to park in Newington and access the Seabrook Stream area by taking the Elham Valley Way southwards. There is a free car park by the former Elham Valley Railway, accessed via a ramp running north-west from the road between Newington and Peene.

## Bird species diversity

The tetrad has produced an overall total of 108 species, which ranks as the 22<sup>nd</sup> richest in diversity amongst the 31 local tetrads as the table below demonstrates. The number of breeding and wintering species relate to those recorded in the 2007-2013 BTO/KOS atlas fieldwork.

### Other Natural History

The tetrad contains part of the Seabrook Stream SSSI. The interest of this site centres on the alder carr and fen communities that support an exceptional number of cranefly species. The varied geology over the course of the stream has given rise to a range of conditions in which different habitats have developed in close proximity.

Base-rich springline alder carr has developed on the wettest soils and here the ground flora is varied. Characteristic species such as opposite-leaved Golden Saxifrage and Lesser Pond-sedge are frequent in some areas along with Marsh Marigold and Yellow Flag Iris. In the west of the site where a tributary stream arises there are more willows and the ground flora is dominated by sedges. Where seepages arise above the woodland rich flush communities occur, generally dominated by Great Horsetail and Great Willowherb but also including Marsh Horsetail and Common Spotted-orchid.

On the drier slopes of the valley there is woodland, scrub and neutral grassland. The woodland canopy is dominated by Oak, Ash and Hazel with Bluebells, and Red Campion frequent amongst the ground flora. The scrub is principally of Hawthorn, Elder and Blackthorn.

The whole of the Seabrook valley supports an exceptional number of cranefly species, 67 having been recorded to date from this site alone. This total includes four nationally scarce species. It is the seepages within the alder carr providing a wide range of moisture regimes, that allow this site to support so many species. 14 other invertebrate species found on the site are nationally scarce, including the harvestman *Homalenotus quadridentatus* which occurs in the drier grassland further up the valley sides.

Moth trapping has been undertaken on several occasions at the Seabrook Stream and in 2018 this produced two new species for the area: a *Nascia ciliaris* (Orange-rayed Pearl) in June and an *Acompsia cinerella* (Ash-coloured Crest) in July, whilst in June 2019 Scarlet Tiger was added to the area list here.



At the nearby disused Newington Quarry (in the small section which is within TR13 Y) the first British record of *Pyrausta aerealis* (Folkestone Pearl) was recorded in June 2012, although its origin is uncertain (Atropos no date, Steele 2012). Two specimens of the Four-spotted were found at the Channel Tunnel terminal by day in 2004 and it is possible that an undetected population exists here, or to the north on Folkestone Downs.

Brian Harper has been trapping regularly in a garden in the tetrad between summer 2016 and the end of 2019, and again from early 2021, where he recorded another British first when a *Caloptilia honoratella* (Pale Maple Slender) was taken in April 2019.

Other highlights have included the second area record (but only the 13<sup>th</sup> British record) of *Paracorsia repandalis* (Scarce Straw Pearl) and the second area records of the scarce migrants *Spoladea recurvalis* (Maize Moth) and Purple Marbled.

The first area records of *Ypsolopha mucronella* (Spindle Smudge), *Stenolechia gemmella* (Black-dotted Groundling), *Ancylis comptana* (Little Roller) and *Ancylis diminutana* (Small Festooned Roller) were trapped here, as were the second area records of *Argyresthia curvella* (Brindled Argent), *Grapholita lobarzewskii* (Kent Fruit Piercer), *Pempelia palumbella* (Heather Knot-horn), Brussels Lace and Waved Black.

The third modern area record of Dark Crimson Underwing, the fourth area records of *Matilella fusca* (Brown Knot-horn), Grass Rivulet and Small Marbled, and the first record of Golden-rod Pug away from Folkestone Warren were also of considerable note. Several Pale-shouldered Clouds have been noted and is thought likely to be breeding in the tetrad or nearby.

Other notable migrants have included *Cydia amplana* (Vagrant Piercer), *Acrobasis tumidana* (Scarce Oak Knot-horn), *Palpita vitrealis* (Olive-tree Pearl), Striped Hawk-moth, the Vestal, the Gem, Dewick's Plusia, Bordered Straw, Scarce Bordered Straw and Small Mottled Willow.

Also of particular note have been Portland Ribbon Wave, the Mocha, Chalk Carpet, Barred Rivulet, Channel Islands Pug, Netted Pug, Bloxworth Snout, Rest Harrow, Clouded Buff, Dotted Footman, Oak Rustic and White Spot.

Trapping on the former railway line at Peene has also produced some interesting moths including *Catoptria verellus* (Marbled Grass-veneer), Dusky Hook-tip, Sub-angled Wave, the Blackneck and the Gem.

Brimstone butterflies can be found in the Seabrook Stream SSSI area and the regular migrants Clouded Yellow and Painted Lady have been recorded within the tetrad.

A list of all species recorded in the tetrad is provided below in Appendix 2.

## General History

The most significant feature within the tetrad is the Grade I listed St. Martin's Church. A church has stood here, on the hillside at the top of the Horn Street valley, for over a thousand years. The original building (consisting of the nave and tower) dates from Saxon times, prior to 900AD, and the original Saxon doorway into the tower and a Saxon window can still be seen today.

The Chancel was constructed probably around 1225AD and inside this there are six arches on each side of an Early English style with thin shafts of Bethersden marble. During the fourteenth century the South Aisle was added, and a small chapel, the Enbrook Chapel, appended to the north side. It is probable that around this time the diagonal buttresses on the west outside wall of the tower were added. The church later underwent extensive restoration during the Victorian era and again at the end of the twentieth century.

The churchyard is notable as it contains the grave of Samuel Plimsoll, renowned for creating the "Plimsoll Line" on ships. Samuel Plimsoll retired to Folkestone after being diagnosed with diabetes and died here in 1898 after falling into a diabetic coma.

Another church of note is the Saint Nicholas' at Newington. The earliest reference to place of worship at "Newington-next-Hythe" can be found in the Domesday Book of 1086, whilst the list of priests inside the church door stretches back to 1220. The Nave and Chancel date back to the twelfth century, whilst the font has been dated to the thirteenth century.

The church had a very unusual heating system in use until the late 1940s: beneath the tiled floor were pits about a foot square covered by ventilated iron plates. The pits would have small fires lit inside them which then heated the church, each weekend the ash would be cleaned out and another fire lit. The pits still remain although are now hidden by carpets.

At the village of Peene there is a museum dedicated to the former Elham Valley Railway, which was operational from 1887 to 1947, whilst in the south-east of the tetrad lies Risborough Barracks, part of the Shorncliffe Camp (see TR13 X) for further information.
