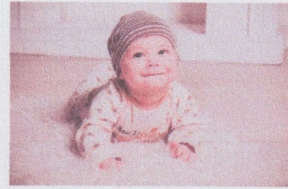


Welcome to the Infant 1 Classroom!

Hello families!

We are so excited to have you as a part of our class! Our Infant 1 Classroom curriculum is focused on preparing your child to transition to the Infant 1 Classroom. We will work on their social-emotional development as well as their overall developmental milestones by using play-based learning and social interactions with teachers and peers. We use the Ages & Stages curriculum to guide individual goal setting and promote independence.

What does my child need?

For the school year, your child will need:

- 1) Backpack/Diaper bag to transport their belongings to and from school.
- 2) 8-10 extra sets of clothes (shirt, shorts/pants, socks) & 1 extra pair of shoes(if walking) to be kept in their cubby
- 3) Diapers and wipes
- 4) Bottles labeled with the child's name & the date



If you have any questions and/or concerns, please do not hesitate to ask or reach out via Procure.

Important Reminders for Preschool:

- Every **MONDAY**, please bring in a fitted crib sheet with a small blanket or sleeping bag for naptime. Every **FRIDAY** we will send them home to be washed and returned the following week unless they get messy during the week.
- Lunches should be healthy choice meals and sent to school in a lunchbox or paper bag labeled with your child's name. **NO PLASTIC BAGS ARE PERMITTED IN THE CENTER!** Please label all containers and water bottles with your child's first and last name AND the date!
- Morning and afternoon snacks are provided at the center as well as juice, water, and milk for buddies 1 years old and older.
- Please be sure to label all sippy cups with your child's name along with the date as well on them.
- In the summer, **WEDNESDAYS** are our water days (weather permitting). Please send your child to school with their bathing suit and water shoes with a cover-up in their backpack. Please be sure to send in their towel as well.
- Please be sure to provide a **NON-AEROSOL** sunscreen for your child that will be kept at the center. Be sure to label the sunscreen with their first and last name.
- If your child requires any medication, a medication administration form will need to be completed by both the parent AND doctor before we can administer the medication. The medication must have the prescription label on it and be labeled and unopened at the time of handing it over to the center (unless it must be sent to and from school).
