

Camp Rules

Our Campground rules have been created with you in mind and are in place to ensure everyone has an enjoyable & safe experience while camping with us. We know there won't be any problems, however, we respectfully ask that you read, acknowledge and adhere to the following rules.

- **Covid-19 safety:**
 - Try to maintain a distance of 6ft (2m) from campers outside of your family
 - Do not enter another camper's site unless there is sufficient room to maintain proper & effective physical distancing
 - The use of community face masks is encouraged when proper physical distancing can not be preserved
 - Frequent hand washing and sanitizing of "high touch" surfaces
 - RV must be equipped with functioning kitchen and bathroom
 - Parents must ensure their children follow physical distancing and Covid-19 safety recommendations
 - No visitors will be permitted during the 2020 season except for designated bubble families of long term campers (Seasonal only)
- **In General:**
 - **BE REASONABLE & RESPECTFUL TO EVERYONE**
 - Be mindful of your belongings, we are not responsible for lost/stolen items
 - We make every effort to keep our Campground clean and tidy for all campers; please help us by using the garbage and recycling bins provided
- **Check in:**
 - Check in time is 12 pm or later
 - Registration and payment must be completed prior to occupying any site
- **Check out:**
 - **Check out time is 11 am or earlier**
 - If you wish to extend your stay please see staff in camp office to check availability and make payment prior to 10 am on day of scheduled departure
- **Speed Limit:**
 - **10 km/hr** is the speed limit in the campground
 - With young children in the campground and around the area we ask that all drivers take special care while driving in campground as well as around the area on Cottage Lane and Camp Road
 - If entering/leaving the camp after dark please use low beam head lights

Resort staff reserve the right to make you vacate the premises should you or your guest not be in compliance with these Camp Rules.

Camp Rules

- **Campsites:**
 - Keep your site tidy during your stay and clean up upon departure
 - One RV unit per site only
 - A screen tent is permitted
 - Max of 4 adults per site
 - Keep all your belongings/gear within your site
 - One vehicle per site
 - Vehicle parking is limited, please see staff if you require assistance with parking outside of your assigned site
 - Do not cut through other campsites
 - Do not do dishes in the Shower House
 - **Be respectful of quiet hours: 10 pm to 8 am**
 - RV Sewer must be properly connected to the service
 - Please ensure all food/garbage is put away to ensure that wildlife is not attracted
- **River:**
 - **Absolutely no garbage or glass of any kind is to be taken to or left by, in or on the river**
- **Camp Fires:**
 - Please use the fire ring provided within your site for fires
 - Firewood can be purchased office
 - Please ensure your fire is completely out any time your site is unattended, upon departure and before turning in for the night
 - **No fireworks**
 - Obey any posted “No fires” signs when such Provincial bans are in effect
- **Pets:**
 - **Owners are responsible for their pets and must ensure proper care, control and behavior of their pets at all times**
 - Promptly clean up after your pet and deposit in the garbage bins provided
 - **Keep your pets on a leash no more than 2 meters long at all times & do not leave your pets unattended**
 - Ensure that your pet does not become a nuisance, danger or threat to the comfort and/or safety of any other person or pet on site
- **Smoking:**
 - Smoking is permitted in your assigned site
 - **No smoking in common areas, Shower House, Clubhouse or Pool areas**
 - Please do not leave cigarette butts on the ground, they can be disposed of in the fire pits
 - Please do not put cigarette butts in the garbage to avoid fire hazard

Resort staff reserve the right to make you vacate the premises should you or your guest not be in compliance with these Camp Rules.

Camp Rules

• **Drinking:**

- **BE REASONABLE & RESPECTFUL**
- Keep empties tidy, bins for empties are provided
- **Drinking and driving of any type of vehicle will NOT be tolerated**

• **Pool ~ Covid-19 restrictions will be posted at the pool:**

- **NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY ~ USE AT OWN RISK**
- No one should swim alone
- Anyone 16 or younger must be accompanied by an adult
- **DIVING IS NOT PERMITTED**
- Be respectful of others using the pool
- No running around or in the pool
- No rough play in or around the pool
- Clean up after your pool time and be sure to take all your belongings with you
 - We are not responsible for lost/stolen items
- **No glass or other breakable items in the pool area**
- **No alcohol in the pool area**
