May 22nd

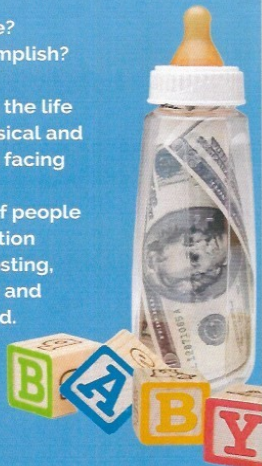
Our youth will be leading worship on this date. Be in prayer for them as they plan. The theme is "Christ Over Crisis."
