PHASE ONE COMPLETED!!!

The first step toward the installation of the new climate control system is finished. Fourteen wells have been drilled on the front terrace and the pipes connected into the mansion. The contractors are conducting the repair to the lawn and it soon will not be apparent where the work was done.

This is one of the reasons a continuous-loop geothermal system was chosen to heat and cool the mansion. There will be no noisy compressors or other equipment on the lawn.

We are now ready for the next step – the installation of the equipment and ductwork to complete the first floor system. The cost for the first floor will be about \$50,000 which we will raise from grants and gifts.


At the same time the electrical service must be enhanced. The service coming into the mansion at this time is not large enough. A new electrical cable must be put in from the pole into the mansion. The cost of this will be raised from our **Community Support Endeavor.** Local benefactors and businesses have been asked to contribute \$1,000 or more. Pledges and donations are at a total of \$3,200 and growing.

Volunteers are needed to prepare for the installation of ductwork. Most of the ceilings must be torn down and the debris removed. We are looking for a few hearty people to be our demolition crew! Interested? Call Norma Bair at 800-684-2232.
