In the golden era of guitars (you know – those years that created the great "vintage" instruments that bring high dollars today) manufacturers would follow a basic formula for developing a guitar and bringing it to market. It went something like this. First, they would have a design and functional idea. They would then build prototypes, which would be shown to top players in order to get product feedback. Needed changes would then be made, factory cost of producing the product would be calculated and an anticipated profit margin would be added. A dealer cost and resulting suggested selling price would then be determined. This sounds basic and simple doesn't it? Today most companies unfortunately are only concerned with price point to sole proprietary dealers and balance or average this price to what they need to do to sell it to the national chains and department stores.

The people who make up the Tradition Guitar Company have lived through all of this. They are representatives, telemarketing specialists, ex-music retailers, and all are guitar and bass players. They would not and could not accept the trend our industry was taking so they took up a collection (so to speak) and tried their best to do something that would be good for the industry, good for the dealers and most importantly, good for the guitar players. All of them agreed the world did not need "just another guitar line". When a guitarist tries a Tradition, the response is always "This guitar sounds and plays great!" Believe it or not this didn't happen by accident. It is and has always been Tradition's goal to give the player the best value per dollar spent while helping to keep our dealers in business. Tradition dealers are the key to this industry and to the guitarist. Good dealers provide the consumer with product evaluation, product knowledge, and service.

We sometimes get feedback about our low prices. Some players start to look for something "wrong" or a trick of sorts because the value is so high for the prices we charge. In case you are wondering there is no trick at all! Tradition owns its own distribution warehouse (we don't pay rent) that is climate controlled. Tradition does not have an army or bureaucrats (marketing managers, advertising managers, account directors, a credit department, and all the assistants and sub-assistants that goes with this mess). We do have a very "lean" staff of dedicated people who all work too hard and work too many hours. We don't spend a lot of money on national ad campaigns because we feel that the only way for anyone to choose a guitar is to play and compare it to others. Advertising expense is built into the cost of every other line out there and the consumer is the one who pays for it as an end result. By keeping this expense to a minimum, we are able to save the players a substantial amount of money.




