How to Craft the Perfect Personal Introduction

Personal Introductions are all about making a big impression in a small amount of time! It's important to enter the stage with confidence and smile throughout your speech while looking at both the judges and the audience. Make sure to include, at minimum, your name, your hometown/region/University, and at least one thing that's special about you. For those in MME (that's Miss division and above), you'll need to also include a brief description or overview of your service platform. Your service platform is a cause, volunteer service project, or awareness campaign that is personally important or meaningful to you.

There is a timer to keep track of the 45 second time limit but a 5 second grace period is allowed without point deduction.





Quick Notes:

- 1. All Personal Introductions have a maximum time limit of 45 seconds.
- 2. Especially for younger age categories, sometimes shorter and well-executed Personal Introductions are the most successful.
- 3. Personal Introductions will be performed in your Interview Attire (for those Teen and under, this is your 2022 HeartShine t-shirt and black pants/skirt)
- 4. A cordless mic will be handed off to the contestant (no mic stand/cords to worry about) You will walk to your mark in the center front of stage to begin.

QUICK TIPS:

- The formal wear walking routine is as follows:

 enter stage left, you'll take a few stairs up to the stage, (2) hold pose on your first X (mark), just up from the stairs on the left/start of your walk, (3) continue to the center of the stage and perform a turning movement of your choice such as a circle turn, a pivot turn, subtle poses, etc. (4) move to your final X(mark) back at the center of the stage and gently hold a final pose, (5) exit the stage while gently waiving (with your arm extended over your head) with arm farthest behind you as you exit the stage (one last smile at the judges is a nice touch).
- 2. An amazing Formal Wear dress doesn't have to be expensive. Judges are looking for inner-beauty and poise, if you feel beautiful, confident and love your dress, chances are the judges will too!
- 3. The entire Formal Wear routine will last approximately 25 seconds but will vary slightly between contestants.
- 4. Your EMCEE CARD bullet points will be read aloud by the emcee as you perform your Formal Wear. Your Emcee Form will be available in the next Contestant Packet.

Formal Wear Tips and Tricks

Formal Wear competition is a crowd favorite where you showcase your elegance. confidence and poise on stage during the grand finale in a formal, floor-length gown. You want to practice your walk, with your stage shoes, keeping in mind that you're trying to give the impression that you're gliding across the stage, good posture, completely confident and shining from the inside-out. Making eye contact with both the judges and the audience is recommended. don't rush. this is YOUR time to shine! Stand tall. smile, and Let Your Heart Shine Bright!

For Arrival and Rehearsals:

Any upscale casual, age appropriate outfit is perfect for arrival and rehearsals.



Your arrival outfit is not judged, but judges and staff will be out and about throughout pageant weekend as well. Please bring your best self to every HeartShine event because media & cameras will be everywhere! Be naturally, beautifully YOU from the inside out and you'll shine!

For Interviews:



IF YOU ARE IN TEEN OR UNDER DIVISION: Your Interview outfit is the same as your opening number attire! (Pink 2022 Logo Tshirt and black pants/skirt)

IF YOU ARE IN MISS AND ABOVE DIVISION: Your Interview Outfit is professional interview attire of your choice (closed toed shoes suggested). For all age divisions, hair should be styled up and away from the face, polished and ready to shine!

For Any Optional Competition:

OPTIONAL CONTESTS ARE NOT REQUIRED.

On-Stage Optionals include Modeling and Talent. HeartShine State's Modeling theme this year is "Decades" (60s, 70s, 80s, etc.), so please come prepared to perform your high-energy walk on stage in an age-appropriate "Decades" casual or semicasual outfit. Talent attire is anything appropriate for your performance. For those under 18, dance-shorts are recommended under dance leotards (over-all age-appropriate attire modifications).

For the Off-Stage Optionals, any attire appropriate for you entry and makes you feel confident would be perfect!

For the Think Pink Pajama Party:



For the Think Pink Pajama Party Saturday night, wear your cutest PJ's and get ready to be surrounded by lots of the color pink! Be comfortable, wacky, silly, or even nighttime glam at this fun dance event. This is a closed party, but pictures and videos will be taken (boys and girls, moms and dads, and supporters will all be in the same room). Get ready to dance your pink socks off!

What to Wear

for HeartShine Stage Pageant Weekend 2022

For Opening Number (Performed During Grand Finale):



FOR ALL CONTESTANTS: Opening Number Outfit includes your 2022 Pink Logo T-shirt, black bottoms (skirt/pants), and a neutral shoe of any height (black, white, nude). Please do not modify (cut, bedazzle, etc.) the t-shirt prior to Grand Finale. If desired, safety pins can be used to 'tuck' the shirt in at the waist or make some subtle fitting changes. Accessories are allowed but should not distract from the overall look.



For Personal Introduction (Performed During Grand Finale):



FOR THOSE IN TEEN AND UNDER DIVISION: Your Personal Introduction outfit is the same as your Opening Number outfit. FOR THOSE IN MISS AND ABOVE DIVISIONS: Your Personal Introduction outfit is the same (or similar) outfit as your Interview, professional attire. You will need to change immediately after Opening Number is complete.

For Formal Wear (Performed During Grand Finale):

Your formal wear gown should be full length, a special style and color that compliments you and your personality. Short trains are ok - no large hoops or long trains, please. Your dress shoes not drag or cause you any tripping concerns, you should not need to "lift" your gown with your hands, except possibly entering or exiting the stage stairs. A well-fitted dress is a beautiful dress!

NOTE: Please have the skirt of your dress be full-length all the way around (no high-low hem designs)




If you LOVE your gown, it will increase your confidence and your comfortablity on stage. Take your time and enjoy your formal wear walk and make sure you can wear your choice of shoes comfortably and elegantly. In most cases we suggest staying away from black or dark colors, but overall your gown should suit your unique style and taste.

Note: No plunging necklines, slits above the knee, or low-backs for those under 18 please.

ARTIST

Any subject and any medium is welcome! In this application, you'll find guidelines for size and weight limits.

SCRAPBOOK

Scrapbook is open for lots of creativity! It is also typically one of the least-utilized Optional Contests, meaning there might be greater chances to win! Like Artist and Community Service, Scrapbook entries must be brought with you (physical copy) to pageant weekend for check-in.

For Actress, prepare a short advertisement to perform for any product or service. Record and upload your video using this form (right). Open the form to see an example of an ad you could perform! You can also make up your own ad! Hot tip: Make sure you (the contestant) is well-lit for the video and viewers can clearly see your face.





Photogenic

This entry form (left) is the standard photogenic contest. Your upload can be the same headshot you're using for your contestant headshot but it doesn't need to be.

NOTE: This is NOT the "decades" theme-photo contest. This is a standard Photogenic entry.
