The Rider, named Faithful and True, judges and makes war in pure righteousness.




High School Friend Joni Elizondo Zepp suggested putting a vision board together.

He has, and continues to do great and mighty things, in Jesus name, Amen! \o/


As things were winding down a bit, I sat a few minutes with my children in the counseling room, also the office.



The Prayer Room




The Greeting Room + Kitchenette
