From the Deacon's Desk

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

"Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven." In the first readings we hear what many of us would consider a pessimistic view of life. "Vanity of vanities" it says, that, no matter how intelligent we are, how skillful we may be, or even how hard we work everything is in vain. The second reading we are pointed toward in the right direction. "If you were raised with Christ, seek what is above, where Christ is seated at the right hand of God." The gospel is where we are able understand the two readings together. A person in the crowd asks Jesus to intercede in the unjust treatment of one brother regarding their share of the inheritance. Jesus' reply is not to judge the situation of the two brothers, but rather to speak to their hearts, filled with greed. It may seem to us that the brother who has been cheated out of his share of the inheritance is right and the other is wrong; however, the first brother is ready to renounce his own blood brother for the sake of his share of the inheritance. Jesus continuing to speak tells them a parable about a man with an overabundance of things stored up but will die. Jesus finishes the parable by saying, "Thus will it be for all who store up treasure for themselves but are not rich in what matters to God." We should all ask ourselves the value of our riches... When the Israelites entered the promised land each of the twelve tribes received an inheritance, that is a portion of the land, all except one tribe. "...Levi has no portion or inheritance with his brothers; the Lord is his inheritance..." (Dt. 10:9) Let us pray brothers and sisters that we may inherit the Lord, that is the gift of the Holy Spirit, God's indwelling within us.

En las primeras lecturas escuchamos lo que muchos de nosotros consideraríamos como una visión pesimista de la vida. "La vanidad de las vanidades" dice que, no importa lo inteligentes que seamos, lo hábiles que podamos ser, o incluso lo duro que trabajemos, todo es en vano. La segunda lectura nos apunta hacia la dirección correcta. "Si te criaron con Cristo, busca lo que está arriba, donde está sentado Cristo a la diestra de Dios". El evangelio es donde podemos entender las dos lecturas juntos. Una persona en la multitud le pide a Jesús que interceda en el trato injusto de alguien que se preocupa por su parte de la herencia. La respuesta de Jesús no es juzgar la situación de los dos hermanos, sino hablarles a sus corazones, llenos de codicia. Nos puede parecer que el hermano que ha sido engañado de su parte de la herencia tiene razón y el otro está equivocado; sin embargo, el primer hermano está listo para renunciar a su propio hermano de sangre por el bien de su parte de la herencia. Jesús continúa hablando y les dice una parábola sobre un hombre con una sobreabundancia de cosas almacenadas pero que morirá. Jesús termina la parábola diciendo: "Así será para todos los que almacenan tesoros para sí mismos pero no son ricos en lo que le importa a Dios". Todos debemos preguntarnos el valor de nuestras riquezas ... Cuando los israelitas entraron a la tierra prometida cada uno de las doce tribus recibieron una herencia, que es una porción de la tierra, todas excepto una tribu. "... Levi no tiene parte ni herencia con sus hermanos; el Señor es su herencia ... "(Dt. 10: 9) Oremos a los hermanos y hermanas para que podamos heredar al Señor, ese es el don del Espíritu Santo, la morada de Dios dentro de nosotros.

Pode parecer-nos que o irmão que foi roubado de sua parte da herança está certo e o outro está errado; no entanto, o primeiro irmão está pronto para renunciar ao seu próprio irmão de sangue por causa de sua parte da herança. Jesus continuando a falar lhes conta uma parábola sobre um homem com uma superabundância de coisas armazenadas, mas que morrerá. Jesus termina a parábola dizendo: "Assim será para todos os que acumulam tesouros para si mesmos, mas não são ricos naquilo que importa para Deus". Todos devemos nos perguntar o valor de nossas riquezas ... Quando os israelitas entraram na terra prometida cada um das doze tribos recebeu uma herança, que é uma porção da terra, todas exceto uma tribo. "... Levi não tem parte ou herança com seus irmãos; o Senhor é a sua herança ... "(Deuteronômio 10: 9) Rezemos aos irmãos e irmãs que herdemos o Senhor, que é o dom do Espírito Santo, que Deus habita em nós.




