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Mission Impact

Mission

To provide educational resources to k - 12 students in San Antonio public schools who lack the necessities for academic success

This section gives insight into what is important to A+ Academic Resources and shows the impact our programs and services have on mission accomplishment. The organization's programs and services are consistent with its mission and tax exempt purpose. As indicated below, our programs are striving to significantly impact the communities we serve.

Academic Resources Program

The Academic Resources Program provides academic resources such as (a) school uniforms, (b) gym shoes, (c) backpacks, (d) books, and (e) school supplies for children to go to school and learn. These resources are provided to children in need. Beneficiaries are students attending public schools, from K - 12 grade. A total of **\$4,738** supported **335** students.

Boysville

Boysville received \$300 for school supplies for 15 children. The students are very appreciative!

Child Advocates San Antonio (CASA)

CASA received \$1,700 in educational resources for 85 children. The students are so thankful!

San Antonio Independent School District (SAISD)

SAISD received **\$750** to purchase school supplies for students while they learn remotely. Educational resources enriched the learning experience for **37** students. Additionally, we provided a **\$1,000** to support **100** students through the SAISD Foundation's *Book Buddies Program*. The students are super grateful for our compassionate donors who recognize the importance of books for student success. SAISD received a total of **\$1,750** in academic resources for **137** students.

College and Career Track

Career Resource Center (CRC)

The CRC provides relevant, informative, and timely resources to students as they look ahead to the next step after high school graduation. A total of 2,291 was allocated to the CRC to provide students with educational materials for college & career success. Top Professionals shared a wealth of experience and expertise to set students up for success in career, work, and life. The CRC offers career resources "24/7/365". Significantly, the CRC is available for students worldwide! This is in alignment with our Vision of providing educational resources to K - 12 students worldwide who lack the necessities for academic success. We welcome feedback & ideas from SAISD & TCA Administrators, Staff, Teachers, and Students to make the CRC world-class.

The 10-week Dream Career Academy (DCA) program includes:

- Welcome box mailed to student- (Includes DCA T-Shirt, DCA Journal, The College Strategy Workbook, and other goodies)
- 5-module lessons (students will have up to a year to access the material in their online member center)
- 5-group coaching calls
- 1 -on-1 coaching call with me
- Coursework sheets, tools & templates
- Weekly personal development exercises
- Bi-weekly momentum text messages to maintain student engagement
- A custom pre-college career plan



Two more TCA students (5 students in DCA cohort 1) from the San Antonio Highlands Campus are attending the DCA. They will develop a solid plan to go forward and realize their dreams. College and career success are made possible by developing concrete steps to follow on the pathway to success! A total of **\$1,595** was applied to student tuition which includes books and other essential academic resources such as laptops for students to connect with the CRC and DCA. The total cost of 3 laptops for students was **\$696**. The students are beyond grateful!
