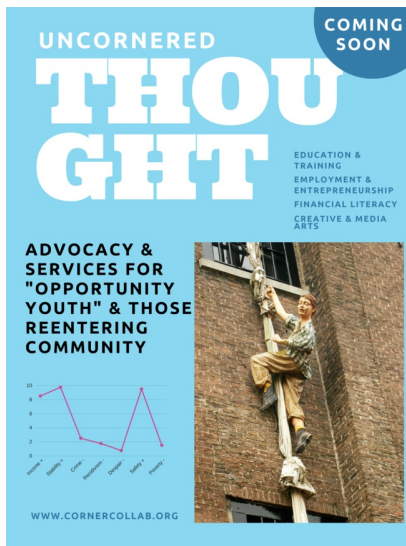

West Palm Beach - We are excited to announce an opportunity for a Clinical Associate/ Phlebotomist to join our community health efforts in Palm Beach County and Broward County. The Phlebotomist represents the face of our company to clients engaged through the HeartThrob Mobile Community Health Initiative, both as part of the clinical service delivery and for providing support for referrals and life-defining health decisions. The Phlebotomist has direct contact with clients and creates an atmosphere of trust and confidence while explaining procedures to clients and drawing blood specimens for the **PULS Cardiac Test** and other lab outcomes from the drawn sample (such as Hemoglobin A1C) in a skillful, safe and accurate manner.



Ft. Lauderdale - Cornerstone has begun recruiting Community Engagement Volunteers representing the company to clients engaged through the HeartThrob Mobile Community Health Initiative and in other program areas. The Community Engagement Volunteer may have direct contact with the public while explaining the community health program to health-seekers and may also devote their time to helping our staff behind the scenes. The Community Engagement Volunteers demonstrate excellent skills and sensitivity to confidentiality and accuracy, and may become eligible to receive formal training as a community health worker through our partnership with the **Urban League of Broward County**.



Tallahassee - In the formation of Cornerstone's Think-Tank concept to develop a "Hub for Poverty Solutions" that can shape public policy and the use of public-private resources, Cornerstone is



preparing to launch an internship opportunity in January to support the efforts of staff and volunteers in a timely and professional manner. Interns in the Tallahassee area will primarily provide program support, administration, and creative ideas to help achieve strategic goals in one or more of three areas: marketing, advancement, and data management.
