INTRODUCTION: (May 31)

"The Season of Pentecost," Pentecost occurring 50 Days after the Resurrection of Jesus Christ Pentecost, also, recognizes "The Birth of the New Testament Church." In today's times, "Pentecost" includes periods of time for persons to receive/receive a "re-filling" of the Holy Ghost/Holy Spirit.

Emphasis: Receiving/Re-filling/Maintaing of the Holy Ghost/Holy Spirit **QUESTION:** "What will you/your Church do during thids special season?

Together, these 2 sub-themes form an important means for helping you to be ready to inherit an Everlasting Life with Jesus Christ! Isn't that <u>ASTOUNDING</u>, <u>PRODIGIOUS</u>, <u>AWESOME</u>, <u>too WONDERFUL</u> for any word in our vocabularies to describe? <u>JUST THINK</u>: <u>our MANSION in HEAVEN is already prepared for us</u>. <u>It is just waiting for us to get to it - AND - all it takes is for us to be ready to inherit it - through our <u>OBEDIENCE to GOD</u>, exhibited by our <u>GODLY</u>, <u>RIGHTEOUS LIVING</u> as is in <u>HIS WORD</u> throughout the Bible (as you observe in your colored markings showing <u>OBEDIENCE to GOD</u> (depicting <u>GODLY/RIGHTEOUS LIVING</u>, using your red marker) vs. <u>DISOBEDIENCE to GOD exhibited by UNGODLY/UNRIGHTEOUS LIVING</u>, using your green marker</u>

BACKGROUND: (May 319)

120 Apostles and followers of Jesus Christ – including women – went into the Upper Room in Jerusalem to await the coming of the Holy Ghost. After 10 days, they received the Holy Ghost (Acts 2:4). (Note: 40 days of Jesus on earth <u>after</u> His Resurrection, plus 10 days of waiting for the Holy Ghost = 50 days. These 50 days = **Pentecost**: "The Birth of the New Testament Church.")

Beginning with *Pentecost*, many wonderful things occurred: The Church - called "The Way" - began, as described in "The Book of the Acts of the Apostles," etc.

INFORMATION to KNOW DURING THE MONTH OF JUNE, etc.: (May 31)

- 1) Praying and Fasting. Be prepared for the receiving/re-filling/maintaining of the Holy Ghost (essential if you want eternal life with Jesus Christ).
- 2) Reading and studying the "First Church," (The Book of Acts).
