

Duck & Elk Watershed Initiative (DEWI)

Eligible grant items are detailed below and determined by a TDF area forester and specified in a prescription plan. Find your TDF forester in the below link. <u>https://www.tn.gov/agriculture/forests/staff.html</u>

Max Grant Limit: \$15,000.00 Min. Grant Limit: \$200.00

Match Funds: 50%-100%

Most components are 50% with the exception of midstory vine removal, site prep for natural regen, and hardwood crop tree release which are 75%. TDF seedlings are cost shared at 100%.

Sign up: May 1- May 31 and October 1- October 31.

Eligible Grantees:

- Private Individuals
- Non-Profits
- Corporations without publicly-traded stock

Eligible Practices and Components:

Afforestation and reforestation (100% costs covered for purchased TDF seedlings)

- Artificial regeneration (softwoods, hardwoods, shrubs, and other perennials)
 - Seedlings, *container, *cuttings
 - Labor
 - Underplanting
 - Protective tubes
- *Non-timber forest products
 - Alley Cropping
 - Feathered Edge
 - Multifunctional riparian buffers
- Site Preparation
 - Competition Control
 - Prescribed burning
 - Subsoiling
 - Other site preparation
