



## EAHA Youth Club

### How to Qualify for Highpoint & Reserve Awards

- 1) Join the EAHA Youth Club! Shows and points earned prior to joining the EAHA Youth Club will NOT count.



~ One Highpoint or Reserve per EAHA Youth Club member ~	
<p>One Rider</p>  <p>John Smith – 12 years old as of Jan. 1<sup>st</sup></p>	<p>One Horse</p>  <p>Sir Bucksalot, a/k/a “Bucky” (Pick one name and stick with it all season. If you ride Sir Bucksalot in one show/class and Bucky in another, then you have ridden two different horses according to the show records sent to the pointskeeper.)</p>

- 2) Obtain a copy of the **2022 EAHA Youth Club Rules** and read them. If you have any questions, contact the EAHA Youth Club Director, Kathryn Reams or Katie Batson, or email [eahayouth@yahoo.com](mailto:eahayouth@yahoo.com).
- 3) In the **EAHA Youth Club 2022 Rules**, find your category to see what classes count toward that category’s awards.
- 4) For the points of a class to count, you must:
- Show the same horse in the same class in at least eight (8) shows
  - At least two (2) of the eight (8) shows must be “EAHA Youth Club” horse show dates

There are 17 horse shows in the 2022 EAHA Show Schedule: <https://achrc.com/horse-shows>



- ALL 17 shows count toward EAHA Youth Club awards. (The more shows you ride and the more classes in your category that you show in, the more chances for points.)
- Four (4) of those shows are EAHA Youth Club shows (4/9/22, 5/21/22, 5/21/22, 7/30/22) – put those on your calendar and be sure to show your horse, in your classes, in at least 2, if not all 4, of those shows.

## EAHA Youth Club How to Qualify for Participation Award

1) Join the EAHA Youth Club! Shows and points earned prior to joining the EAHA Youth Club will NOT count.

~ One Participation Award per EAHA Youth Club member ~	
<p>One Rider</p>  <p>Jane Smith – 13 years old as of Jan. 1<sup>st</sup></p>	<p>One Horse</p>  <p>Sister Too, a/k/a “Sister” (Pick one name and stick with it all season. If you ride Sister Too in one show/class and Sister in another, then you have ridden two different horses according to the show records sent to the pointskeeper.)</p>

2) Obtain a copy of the **2022 EAHA Youth Club Rules** and read them. If you have any questions, contact the EAHA Youth Club Director, Kathryn Reams or Katie Batson, or email [eahayouth@yahoo.com](mailto:eahayouth@yahoo.com).


3) For the shows to count, you must:

- Show the same horse in the same class in at least eight (8) shows.
- At least one (1) of the eight (8) shows must be an “EAHA Youth Club” show date.

There are 17 horse shows in the 2022 EAHA Show Schedule: <https://achrc.com/horse-shows>

- ALL 17 shows count toward EAHA Youth Club awards.
- Four (4) of those shows are EAHA Youth Club shows (4/9/22, 5/21/22, 5/21/22, 7/30/22) – put those on your calendar and be sure to show your horse, in your class, in at least **1**, if not all 4, of those shows.

**An example of what will and will not count:**

<b>CLASSES SHOWN:</b> <small>(Must be a class that is on every club’s showbill.)</small>	<b>How many total shows shown in this class?</b>	<b>How many Youth Club shows shown in this class?</b>	<b>Points Count toward Youth Club Participation Award?</b>
Showmanship at Halter – 17 & Under	<b>11</b>	<b>3</b>	<b>Yes</b>
Youth English Pleasure – 17 & Under	9	0	No*
Walk-Trot – 13-17	<b>8</b>	<b>2</b>	<b>Yes</b>
Youth Western Pleasure – 17 & Under	7	1	No*
Stake Race 13-17	<b>8</b>	<b>1</b>	<b>Yes</b>
Youth Barrels – 13-17	<b>10</b>	<b>2</b>	<b>Yes</b>
<p>*Show scenarios like these classes will not be counted toward participation awards because they did not meet the “number of shows” (8) or the “number of EAHA Youth Club shows” (1) criteria.</p> <p>Any <u>one</u> of the classes above with a “Yes” would have earned her the participation award (only one participation award per youth).</p>
