Q. What is Repentance unto life?

A. Repentance unto life is a saving grace, worked in the heart of a sinner by the Spirit and Word of God, in which the sinner, out of the sight and sense, not only of the danger, but also of the filthiness and offensiveness of his sins, and upon the apprehension of God's mercy in Christ to such as are penitent, he so grieves for and hates his sins, as that he turns from them all to God, purposing and endeavoring constantly to walk with him in all the ways of new obedience.

God Calls His People to Repentance

Let not sin therefore reign in your mortal body, to make you obey its passions. Do not present your members to sin as instruments for unrighteousness, but present yourselves to God as those who have been brought from death to life, and your members to God as instruments for righteousness. For sin will have no dominion over you, since you are not under law but under grace. (Romans 6:12–14)

God's People Confess Their Sin

O Lord our God and Heavenly Father, we confess to You our sins. We have been filled with worry and anxiety in this season. We have allowed the joy and light of Christ's incarnation for us to be eclipsed in our hearts and minds with other matters. We have been like Martha, anxious and troubled by many things, but neglecting the good portion. We have failed to rest in Christ. More than that, though we purpose and endeavor to walk in new obedience

constantly, we do not! And our endeavors are too often weak and half-hearted at best. Please forgive us. Send Your Spirit on us afresh so that we may rightly and powerfully take hold of Your grace so that we delight in new obedience, hate sin, and rest in Christ's finished work in our place.


