# Alcohol inks workshop



**Bonnie Bodensteiner** will instruct a beginner Alcohol Ink workshop on Saturday, March 11 from 9 a.m until noon at the Danville Art League.

The workshop includes the use of alcohol inks on many different non-porous surfaces. Participants will need to bring a mask (rubbing alcohol used), tight fitting rubber gloves and an apron. The class is limited to 12 participants.
