

### **Adventures in Karate\***

Across the Nation and around the world, we have a family of karate-ka and various adventures await us as we visit with each other. Recently, I had one of these adventures in Chicago with Sensei Bambouyani of the International Traditional Karate Association. Traveling to Chicago on March 10-13 for a work-related conference, I asked Sensei Nakazawa, the Alaska Regional Director of International Shotokan Karate Federation for a suggestion of whom to with train with while in Chicago, his quick response was, "Sensei Bambouyani is there and would welcome you to train," So the accustomed contacts were made between the two Sensei's to introduce me and ask permission to train. I have done this during my various travels across the U.S. and in Europe, but the experience in Chicago was much different and very memorable.

The contact lead, not to a karate training session but to attending the Reception for Women's History Month with Sensei Bambouyani, and hearing a very dynamic speech by Richard M. Daley, the Mayor of Chicago. If you are not familiar with Mayor Daley, he was first elected Mayor of Chicago in 1989 and hails from one of America's best-known political families. In 2005, Time Magazine credited Mayor Daley as one of America's best mayors. In early 2007, Mayor Daley was re-elected for a 6<sup>th</sup> term by more than 70 per cent of the voters, which means that he will equal his father's length of office in December 2010. Mayor Daley's speech focused on the challenges of being a young person today, not only in Chicago but across America. Many adults have misperceptions of youth concerning violence and untimely death. He said the people of Chicago have seen enough violence; have visited too many of their incarcerated children; and been to the morgue too many times. The violence must stop. He inspired the audience to commit to changing this violent direction and promoting a healthier lifestyle. In the audience were many women who, when asked to step forward to help Mayor Daley, all stepped forward. This was a very memorable experience for me, but for those in Chicago, this night sparked a hope for a safer environment and healthier life for the youth of Chicago.

This adventure reflects the caliber of karate instructors who not only dedicated their lives to martial arts training, but to activities directed toward improving their home city. Sensei Banbouyani is a wonderful example of working through his community to make a better life. Thank you to Sensei Nakazawa for the introduction and to Sensei Bambouyani for the highlight of my stay in Chicago.
