

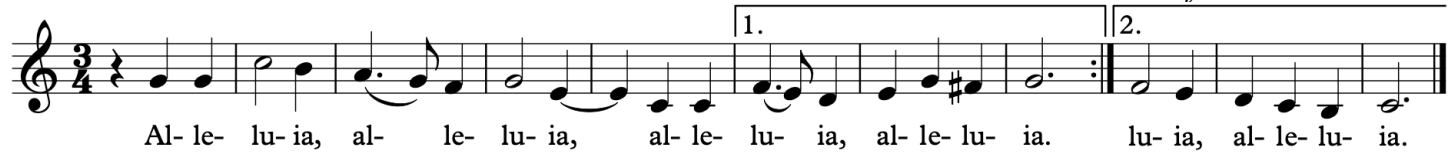

THE NICENE CREED






