

Opening

Host: Well...we are going to get started. My name is_____. Welcome to this meeting of Real Church. We are a Christian fellowship for the truther community.

Let's open this meeting with prayer, followed by a reading of the 23rd Psalm.

- Pray or ask someone to pray, another to read the 23rd Psalm

Psalm 23

6. Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life, and I will dwell in the house of the Lord forever.

Introduction

Host or Trusted attendee:

As we mentioned, this is a Christian fellowship for the truther community. A “truther” is someone, who by the grace of God, has had a veil lifted from their eyes allowing them to see things in this world that seem to be hidden from most people.

Topics that are typically avoided and considered conspiracy theories seem obvious and important to us. The decision to accept the reality of these hidden things has caused us many problems in our relationships with friends’ family and church members.

This Fellowship provides a safe place for believers that are like-minded to share their journey and listen to others do the same.

This is not a recovery group or 12 step program, because standing in the truth is not a vice that we need to be set free from. However, by learning the truth about these hidden topics we have found there are many challenges:

The Fact

We have experienced rejection – Being a truther means that you begin to ask questions about how the world works and you no longer just believe what your told unless it lines up with the facts. The decision to live this way seems to upset a lot of people. As a result, many of us have been given ultimatums by those around us. We have been told by friends and family, never to discuss these topics or they would be forced to break ties with us. We have done all that we could to maintain these relationships but in many cases it proved to be impossible. As a result, we have experienced rejection.

We have experienced isolation - Even when we remained silent, we found these different beliefs caused difficult challenges in our relationships. In many cases, we were told to change back to the way we were or go away. We could not comply and maintain our integrity. And as a result, we experience isolation.

And lastly, **we have been misunderstood**. The term Conspiracy Theory is designed to suggest that we are unstable or insecure. By discrediting the person,

it attempts to nullify their message. This causes friends and family to view us in a way that is disrespectful and demeaning. We have come to terms with the fact that this is a cross that we will gladly bear because when we stand for truth we stand with God. We seek only to obey God who “requires truth in the inward parts.” Unfortunately, many of our loved ones seem unwilling to stand in truth, and as a result we are misunderstood.

The supernatural bible changes represent an unprecedented challenge to our walk with God. But with the help of the Holy spirit and those in this fellowship I am certain that I will be able to stand and for that I am grateful. Amen

Our Purpose

Our purpose in coming together is to assist one another in our common journey. We do this by sharing honestly, out of our own personal experience, the challenges and encouragements of daily Christian living in a world that seems to be unwilling and unable to see the things that have been shown to us.

Our faith and confidence rests in the Lord Jesus Christ and His ability to keep us in these troubled times. Though Bibles may be changing, we know that Jesus Christ is the same yesterday today and forever. Because nothing can separate us from the Love of God, we are strong, unmoved and not afraid because Jesus is King.

Introductions

Host: Let’s take a moment to introduce ourselves. I’ll begin and we’ll go around the room. **Those who wish may give a one-sentence statement of their reason for attending this meeting. This is not the sharing time yet....just a quick introduction.** [Introductions follow].

Sharing Portion

Host: We are now at the sharing portion of our meeting. In sharing, we speak honestly out of our own experience. We tell the truth about ourselves, knowing that the others will listen to us in love and will hold whatever we say in strictest confidence. We try to keep our comments brief, taking care to leave plenty of time for others. We address our statements to the group as a whole rather than

directing them toward any one person. As a rule, we refrain from giving advice to others or instructing them during the meeting, believing that such conversations are best reserved for private moments between friends. As a reminder.....**there will be free and open share time at the end.**

Closing
