Dear brothers and sisters,

COME, HOLY SPIRIT, CREATOR BLEST!

This is the cry of the Church in Pentecost. This feast day that comes from the Jewish feast of Shavuot, when the finger of God will write in the hearts of the people the covenant that God has made with them. This feast is also the birthday of the Church, when the Church is born because God can create communion among different people and form a body. I invite you to all participate and be part of this event. Bring your family and friends and enjoy a wonderful day together with us. I want to remind you that we have started a door-by-door visitation of the parish and I truly invite you to welcome and listen if they knock at your door. We want to invite all to come back to the parish and let them know that God has not forgotten them nor you.
