

MINUTES NOVEMBER 6th 2010

- Item 1 Shihan suggested that the curriculum change by reducing the katas needed for grading. Orange- Gekisai ichi, Yellow- Gekisai ni, Green- Sanchin, Brown- Tensho, Black- Saifa. To take effect immediately.
- Item 2 Instructors panel to consist of Phil, John, Alba, George, Frank and Derek. A tournament panel to be created and to collaborate to ensure that students around Australia have access to the latest training methods. To consist of, Alba, Shannon, Carl, Shaun, Mark Azzopardi and Mark Purvis. The tournament panel will also be able to suggest newer and better ways to teach traditional karate.
