

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

ANGEL FIRE-SOUTHERN MORENO VALLEY COMMUNITY CORPORATION AND
CORPORATION AND
FRANCHISE TAX DEPT

A Nonprofit Corporation

I, the undersigned, in order to form a nonprofit corporation under the New Mexico Nonprofit Corporation laws do hereby certify as follows:

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is ANGEL FIRE-SOUTHERN-MORENO VALLEY COMMUNITY CORPORATION.

ARTICLE II

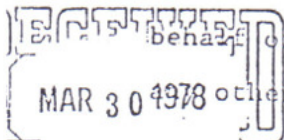
The period of the corporation's duration shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE III

The corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, 1954 (or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue law).

ARTICLE IV

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services actually rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding other provision of these Articles, the corporation shall



not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law) or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Revenue law).

ARTICLE V

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Directors, after paying or making provisions for the payment of all the liabilities of the corporation, shall dispose of all the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law). Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the District Court of the County in which the principal offices of the corporation are located, exclusively for the purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

ARTICLE VI

The initial registered office of the corporation shall be at 215 Lincoln Avenue, Santa Fe, New Mexico, P. O. Box 2228, and the name of the agent therein is James N. Rosel.

ARTICLE VII

There shall be five Directors who shall be elected in the manner and for the terms as established in the By-Laws. The names and addresses of the initial Directors are as follows:
