ABOUT US

Founded in 2019 by Artistic Director, Choreographer, Dance Educator, and Entrepreneur, Jamie Sachs. Under the franchise agreement, Mrs. Sachs is the Executive Director for Miss Riverside City & Miss Grand Terrace Scholarship Programs, official preliminaries to *Miss California* and *Miss America Organization*. The Not-for-profit committee that will volunteer their assistance will feature local Community leaders, Dance Educators, Community Activists, and local businesses. Together, we are a part of over 300,000+ volunteers with the *Miss America Organization*.

OUR MISSION

To provide opportunities for young Riverside and Grand Terrace women to earn financial and in-kind scholarships to trade schools, colleges and universities. We will assist in achieving their educational goals; while encouraging participation in the *Miss California & Miss America Organization*. We will enhance various opportunities through the coaching of special talents, physical fitness and communication skills; while producing positive role models to properly represent the California communities of Riverside & Grand Terrace; with the goal and opportunity to represent California and America. We will promote and encourage the young women with their volunteerism, mentoring and community service to the general public. We will abide by the four points of the Miss America Crown which represent; *“Style, Service, Scholarship, and Success.”*

WHAT WE DO

We produce 2 local programs, Miss Riverside City with Miss Riverside City’s Outstanding Teen & Miss Grand Terrace with Miss Grand Terrace’s Outstanding Teen as official preliminaries to *Miss California & Miss America Organization*. We recruit candidates from the cities of Riverside and Grand Terrace, help them prepare by coaching, mentoring, and counseling the candidates as they prepare to compete in one of our programs depending on which City they are representing. Funds raised through the patronage of local businesses, organizations, and private individuals are awarded in financial scholarships for education and financial assistance for the two different programs to assist Miss Riverside City, Miss Riverside City’s Outstanding Teen, Miss Grand Terrace, Miss Grand Terrace’s Outstanding Teen to meet the expenses associated with preparing for a title. We award educational funding to our title holders as a part of over 30 million dollars of scholarship assistance awarded annually by the *Miss America Organization*.

ELIGIBILITY

To become a title holder, A “Miss” candidate must be 18 years old and a high school graduate or equivalent no later than July 31, and not more than 25 years of age on December 31, 2019. You must be single, never married, never had children, a U.S. citizen, reside, work, or attend school within the City you represent, and of good moral character. Teens Must be 13 by the first day of Miss California's Outstanding Teen Competition held in June and no older than 17 on July 31, 2020. Ages 12 to 17-year-old high-school graduates and non-graduates, as well as 18-year-old non-graduates as of July 31, are eligible to compete as a Teen with the same standards as the “Miss” Candidates. You must live, work and/or attend school within the Cities of Grand Terrace, Highgrove or Riverside for a minimum of 6 months in order to be eligible to compete as a Teen or Miss.



GENERAL Policies *BEFORE* you are eligible to compete in
Miss Riverside City or Miss Grand Terrace Program

Candidates are to make a donation of \$100.00 (*Non-Refundable*) to the “*Children’s Miracle Network*”, A Nationally Sponsored program by the *Miss America Organization*. The donation MUST be made no later than 11:59pm, 7 days before your program. The donation of \$100.00 MUST be paid through the “*Children’s Miracle Network*” website: www.missamerica4kids.org, with proof of payment immediately provided.

<p>Reside in the local competition license area for a period of SIX (6) MONTHS prior to entering a local preliminary competition.</p> <p>Proof will be a California Driver’s License, auto registration, lease in the contestant’s name or any other official document establishing residency.</p>	<p>Completed at least ONE FULL TIME SEMESTER or TWO FULL TIME QUARTERS at a high school, community college or a four year college/university within the State of California and must be currently enrolled as a FULL TIME STUDENT within the license area of the local competition.</p> <p>Proof will be evidence of registration, transcripts or other official documentation from the appropriate educational institution.</p>	<p>Have been a FULL-TIME employee for SIX MONTHS prior to entering the local competition. The physical workplace where you work must be located within the license area of the local competition.</p> <p>Proof will be a letter from the contestant’s employer.</p>

- Must maintain the basis for eligibility throughout the local and State Program
- There are no limits on the number of programs an entrant may enter within a single year. An entrant may enter any local program (closed or open) if she meets the eligibility requirements for that specific local program. However, if she becomes a titleholder, she cannot be a candidate in any other program during that year of service.
- A current titleholder is not permitted to enter the same program in which she won a title the previous year, even if multiple titles are being awarded. She may, however, enter any other program for which she is eligible
