Why: Trusting that our needs will be met today and our wants, if not today, soon, it helps us to express our best self today and make a difference in improving life experience on earth.








What is a Gift Ticket?

A Gift Ticket is a digital gift certificate issued within the DSA *Gift Ticket Swap System (GTSS)* and it may be either for specific products/services provided by the issuer or a gift card from an existing business, (to be) purchased and delivered to the swap partner.

Why Do we need GTSS?

To enable individuals;-

- to share your story and to express your gifts in terms of Gift Tickets.
- to express what you are looking for in terms of specific gift tickets or gift card brands or their categories for swap or exchange consideration.
- to make request and to received request for swap/exchange without limitation of the face value of gift tickets or gift cards.
- to connect with those who are looking for what you offer and vice versa.

SWAP vs Exchange

Swap refers to the process of directly swapping ownership of DSA gift tickets of equal value while **Exchange** refers to the same process but for gift tickets of unequal values where the one with a higher value is discounted to match the value of the other.

Who is GTSS for?

Individuals who want;-

- to make time to share their gifts with others and find what they want in exchange in good time; holistic arts practitioners (all levels are welcome), small business owners, and retired professionals.
- to invest in others' gifts.

What the Program is Today

DSA Gift Ticket SWAP™ Program is currently a prototype system that allows individuals to issue their own digital money, namely, gift tickets, and swap or exchange them with other individuals for what they want.
