

Easter Pastoral Reflections

Easter Change, Transformation: It’s What IT’S All About!

“We were therefore buried with him through baptism into death in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a new life. For if we have been united with him in a death like his, we will certainly also be united with him in a resurrection like his” (Rm. 6:4-5).

He, Christ, Changed, Transformed: Glittering and Radiant—we shall too as Children of The Resurrection! A “person” named “Vanity” thought and explored and discovered what she was: she first became worldly and promiscuous, and sang songs entitled “Nasty”, and then, thru Jesus Christ, changed and grew radiant! She became who she was in Christ—Rev. Look at her picture versus the old ones: radiant and glowing! Children of the Resurrection! We Americans believe change can come in all kinds of ways!

What about Christians?

We are called and pulled and sometimes, like me, thrown to change *into His Resurrection Glory and Radiance!* One soul gave up email for all of lent u can change w/Him : you’re not a child of the Internet you’re a child of the Mystic Net Resurrection Radiance! In “The Third Way” video you can view, I saw same sex attraction persons change into Christ like lives! At a gas station recently I went: I greeted the young man pumping gas and wished him a Happy Good Friday! He thanked me and kept pumping. Just before he left, came over to me, probably after looking at my dirty ramshackle car, and said: “This is for your church!” He gave me a bunch of greenbacks: he changed! He wasn’t just getting gas, it was for him a religious experience-encounter: you can change too—you’re a child of the Resurrection! Now, remember, “united in death with Him and then, *certainly* united with Him in a resurrection like His”! Visualize and image within, often: Him and His Radiant Resurrection growing and flowing thru you! “To live is to change and to be perfect is to change often.” +Cardinal Newman
