RULES AND REGULATIONS OF CONTEST

NOTE: The rules marked with an asterisk are to be ruled on by the local Exhibition Commission (1, 9,)

- 1. ** Christmas trees grown anywhere in Nova Scotia may be entered in this competition.
- 2. Exhibitors may enter in as many Classes as they wish, but no exhibitor shall make more than one entry in a single class either in his own name, the name of a company, a farm, or the name of some other person.
- 3. No trees may be exhibited with limbs or foliage added that did not grow naturally in place.
- 4. No trees may be exhibited that have been sprayed with or have artificial colour or other chemical added in any manner (exception to this rule is fertilizer).
- 5. Trees exhibited will remain the property of the exhibitors and <u>are to be picked up</u> after 6:00 pm on the last day of the Exhibition.
- 6. TREES AND WREATHS MUST BE DELIVERED TO THE EXHIBITION GROUNDS BETWEEN 3:00 & 8:00 PM ON MONDAY, JULY 25, OR THEY WILL NOT BE ELIGIBLE. Judging will commence on Tuesday morning of the Exhibition.
- 7. Entries must be made on entry forms obtained from the South Shore Exhibition and must be in by 4:00 pm FRIDAY, JULY 22.
- 8. Exhibits must have a tag attached showing the name and address of the Exhibitor and the Class number in which the tree is to be exhibited. All entries are to be treated on a first-come, first-serve basis.
- 9. Trees will be watered daily if needed.
- 10. No premiums will be awarded in any class unless the exhibits are worthy. The committee reserves the right to eliminate any tree that is unqualified.
- 11. Trees to be exhibited shall be within the following classes with all height measurements being made from the bottom whorl to the top of the tip; butt length of 24 inches would be appreciated, but not necessary.
- 12. The Committee reserves the right to place any tree in the proper Class if it is entered incorrectly.
- 13. Everyone entering Christmas trees in this competition must sign a statement confirming that these trees were grown either on his or her property or one under lease
