Raley's/Bel Air Something Extra - sign up for this store card by visiting www. raleys.com/extracredit (be sure to designate your contributions to "Coyote Ridge") and every time that you use it, the school will earn $1.5 \%$ per every eligible dollar in a transaction.

Safeway - sign up for this store card and then register the card number at www.escrip.com (be sure to designate "Coyote Ridge" as your school on the eScrip site) and every time you use your Safeway card, the school will earn money. If you need your Safeway card number, please call (877) 723-3929.

Target REDcard - sign up for this credit or debit card and $1 \%$ of all of your purchases will go to Coyote Ridge (and you receive $5 \%$ off of all of your purchases)! Visit target.com/redcard to apply and then be sure to visit target. com/tcoe to designate your school as Coyote Ridge.

Amazon.com - there are two ways to earn money for the school via amazon. com. The preferred way is through the eScrip site. To do this, you need to access amazon.com through the escrip.com web site. Sign in to your eScrip, account, click on "At the Online Mall" and then click on the Amazon link. eScrip will donate $2.4 \%$ of your purchases to the school. The other way
is through Amazon Smile. Visit http:// smile.amazon.com/ch/04-3672762 and sign up for Amazon Smile. Designate Coyote Ridge as your school, and Amazon will automatically donate $0.5 \%$ of your purchases.

Shoparoo - download the Shoparoo App on your iPhone or Android and designate Coyote Ridge as your school (use the code "creft 138 " to earn points for the school when you join). To participate in Shoparoo, all you have to do is snap photos of your store receipts and the school gets money. I have been using this app for about a year now and have not had any problems with privacy issues. It is actually a little addictive! We have earned over $\$ 100$ using this app and Coyote Ridge currently has 34 supporters and about five people that use it regularly - imagine how much we could earn if we could get more supporters!

## TREASURER'S REPORT

Our Viva Las Vegas Spring Gala fundraiser was held on March 5 and turned out to be very successful. The net profit from the event was over $\$ 7,000$, more than $\$ 2,000$ over the budgeted amount. This event was our final fundraiser for the 2014-15 school year rounding out our fundraising total at over $\$ 26,500$ ! Way to go Coyote Ridge families!

As of our March Executive Meeting, total YTD expenses are $\$ 28,049$ while total YTD income is $\$ 48,603$. Major expenses that have occurred since our last newsletter include \$3,910 for

Spring Gala fundraiser, \$2,298 for Field Trip Funding, \$1,597 in Classroom Enrichment to the teachers, $\$ 2,040$ for Walk Thru Revolution program and \$889 in Communications/Copies cost for newsletter printing, 2nd trimester copy costs and copy paper. The significant sources of income since our last newsletter include \$10,759 from our Spring Gala fundraiser and \$1,027 from Raley's Extra Credit. We have had a great budget year so far! Please continue to come out and support your PTA at our upcoming community events including the Mother/Son Boot Camp and the Father/Daughter Dance.


We have done a great job clipping and collecting Box Tops this year! Our latest round of collection resulted in 6,523 Box Tops! The classes that submitted the most Box Tops were Mrs. Bishop's and Mrs. Kandt's classes; congratulations to those
students (and their parents)! We will have a final collection towards the end of the school year, so make sure you clean out your cupboards and clip those Box Tops. Box Tops will be due May 15.
