school supplies, etc.

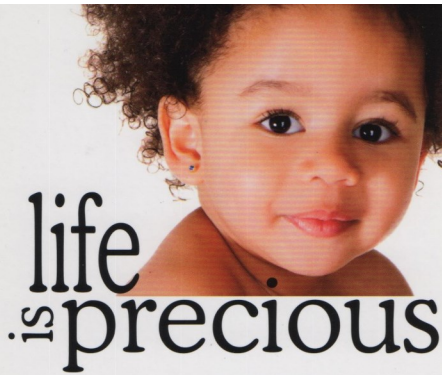
