**MASS READINGS FOR THE 18th. SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME**

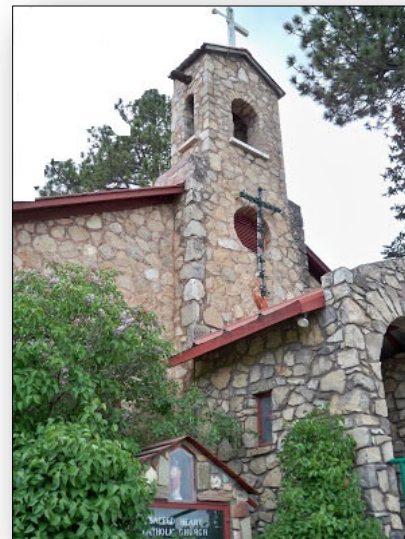
**First Reading** – [Ecclesiastes 1:2; 2:21-23](#): “For what profit comes to man from all the toil and anxiety of heart with which he has labored under the sun?”

**Responsorial Psalm** – [Psalm 90](#): “If today you hear his voice, harden not your hearts.”

**Second Reading** – [Colossians 3:1-5, 9-1](#): “Think of what is above, not of what is on earth. For you have died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God.”

**Gospel** – [Luke 12:13-21](#): “You fool, this night your life will be demanded of you; and the things you have prepared, to whom will they belong?”

The readings for the 18th Sunday in Ordinary Time are a warning against becoming too attached to worldly goods and temporary pleasures. In the first reading we are warned that the things of this world will not bring us lasting joy. The psalm reminds us that our days here are numbered. In the second reading we are reminded to focus on our spiritual lives. In the gospel Jesus tells the parable of the Rich Fool who put all of his energy into acquiring wealth and then suddenly died.
